Big Majority of Men at N. U. in Athletics

Supervised physical training was received by 1,439 men students at Northwestern university during the fall and early winter months, according to figures compiled by Kenneth L. "Tug" Wilson, athletic director. This figure represents 71 per cent of the 1,810 men students enrolled in the schools and departments on the Evanston campus.

A thorough reorganization of the intra-mural department together with a decided increase of men out for varsity and freshman sports has accounted for the large percentage of the men students deriving benefits from the athletic department. Since taking over the athletic helm at Northwestern Director Wilson has worked diligently to give every man student in the university an opportunity to obtain physical training either as a member of a varsity team or through intra-mural teams.

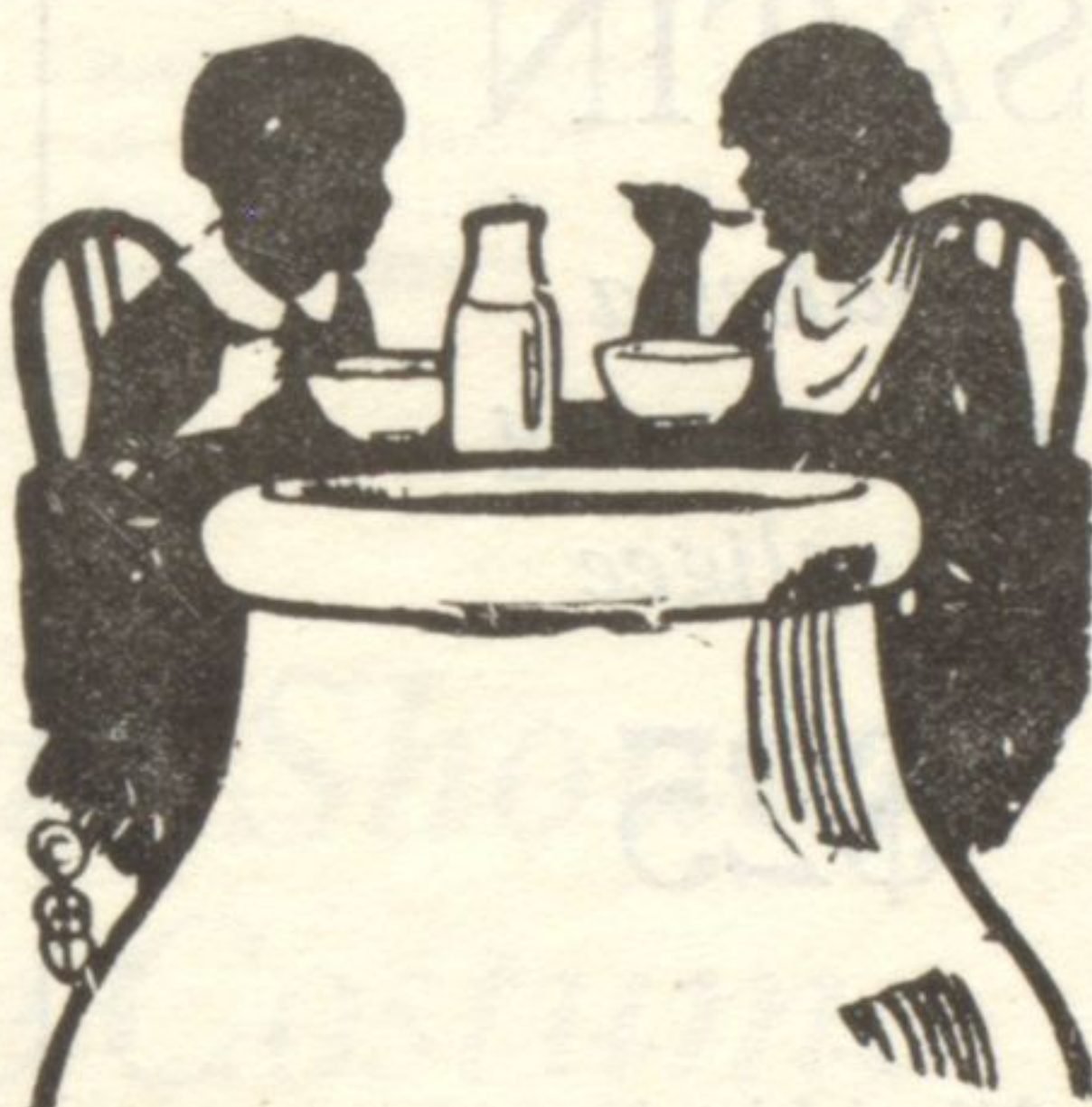
