Hartshorn made a 73 the day before, playing for the first time on the Whitfield Estates course, in a foursome with Jim Senter, William Van Dame and Louis Lancaster. A clipping from the Sarasota Sunday Times, quotes Hartshorn as saying, "Sarasota has two of the best golf courses in the South. The Bobby Jones municipal course is one of the best municipal courses I have seen."
