

Kenilworth Scouts Win Area Rally at Community Center

Plan New Open Dorms on New N. U. Quadrangle

Two new open dormitories for women are to be built by Northwestern university, starting within the next few months, it was announced last Saturday by President Walter Dill Scott. Each will be a home for non-sorority women and will accommodate thirty girls. The buildings will be of Wisconsin, Illinois and Indiana limestone and will fit in the quadrangle now being constructed for the sorority girls of the university.

The new open dormitories will furnish accommodations for only upper class girls who are not members of secret social organizations. With this need taken care of, President Scott, Dean of Women Richardson, Counsellor for Women Mary Ross Potter and other university officials feel that Willard hall may well be turned over to freshmen girls exclusively. Hence, historic Willard Hall, beginning with the formal opening of the two new dormitories in February of 1928, will be a home for freshman girls, who will move in from other quarters and enjoy themselves as only freshmen can.


