Northwestern University Sounds Campus Opinion in Questionnaires Recently Sent Out

An effort to increase religious interest at Northwestern university is being made by Dr. George H. Betts, director of research of the School of Education, and in this connection hundreds of questionnaires sounding the religious opinions of the students have been sent out. Already nearly 2,000 answers have been filed and Dr. Betts is now planning to assemble the material and make a conclusive statement on the best thought of the north shore campus.

Some of the most direct questions are asked and the students are freely making replies, Dr. Betts states. Among these questions are the following:

Do matters of religion frequently occupy your thoughts?

Or do they occupy your thoughts just occasionally, or do they seldom or never occupy your thoughts?

Since you came to Northwestern university has your interest or activity in religion changed?

Do you have greater interest now, or is it less, or has there been any appreciable change?

The students also are being asked as to what form of religion they conform with; if they belong to any religious body, or to any semi-religious organization or society. Also, if they are fraternity or sorority members, and as to what organization has the greatest religious influence over them. If any society or organization is harmful to them, they are asked to report it. They are also questioned upon their dormitory associations, regarding, further, the religious attitude of the campus as they view it; their opinions are asked respecting campus lectures of the campus newspaper, of the quality of their personal friendships, and of the friendliness of the churches and semi-religious bodies toward them.
