NEXT SPEAKER AT COLLEGE

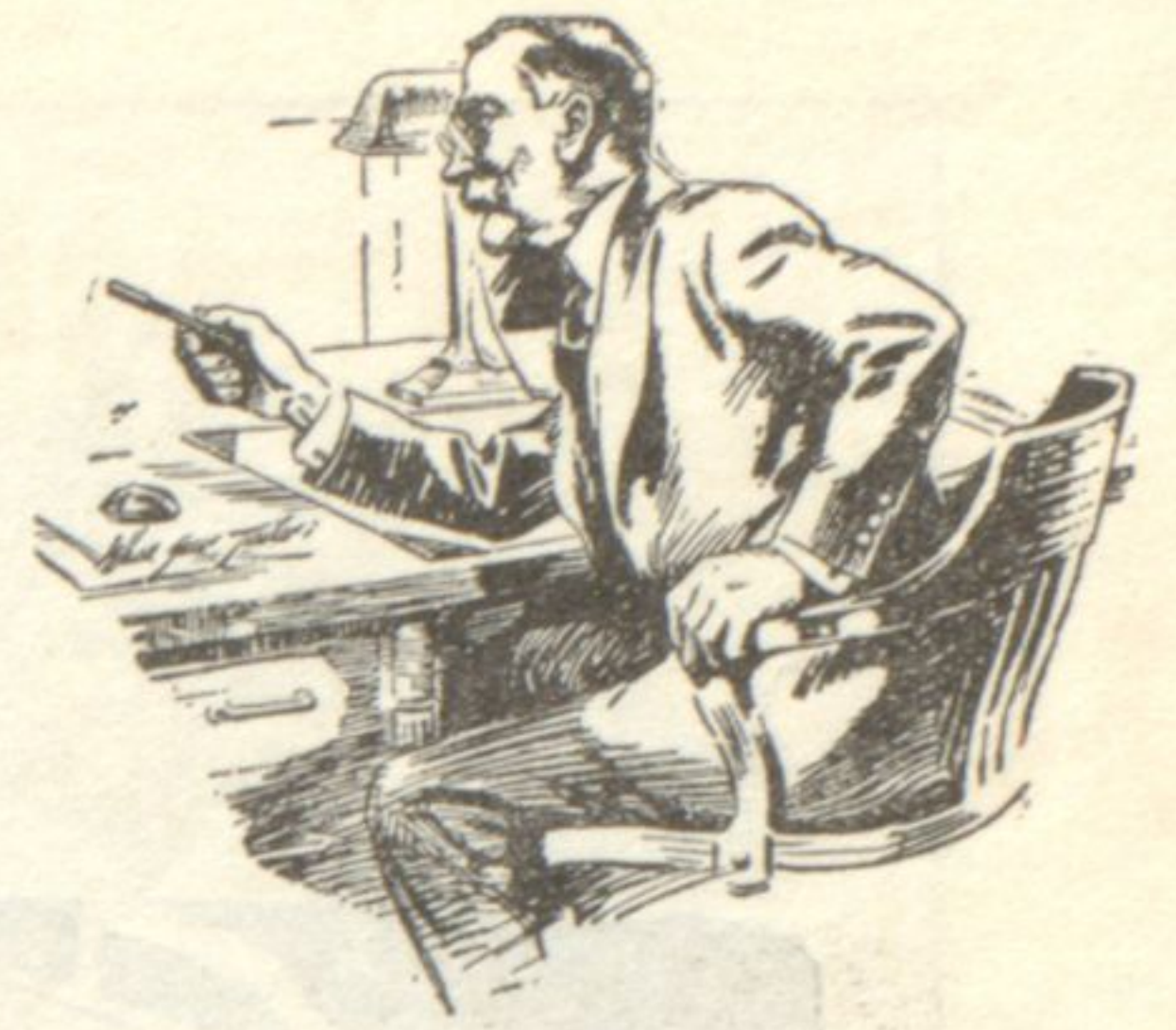

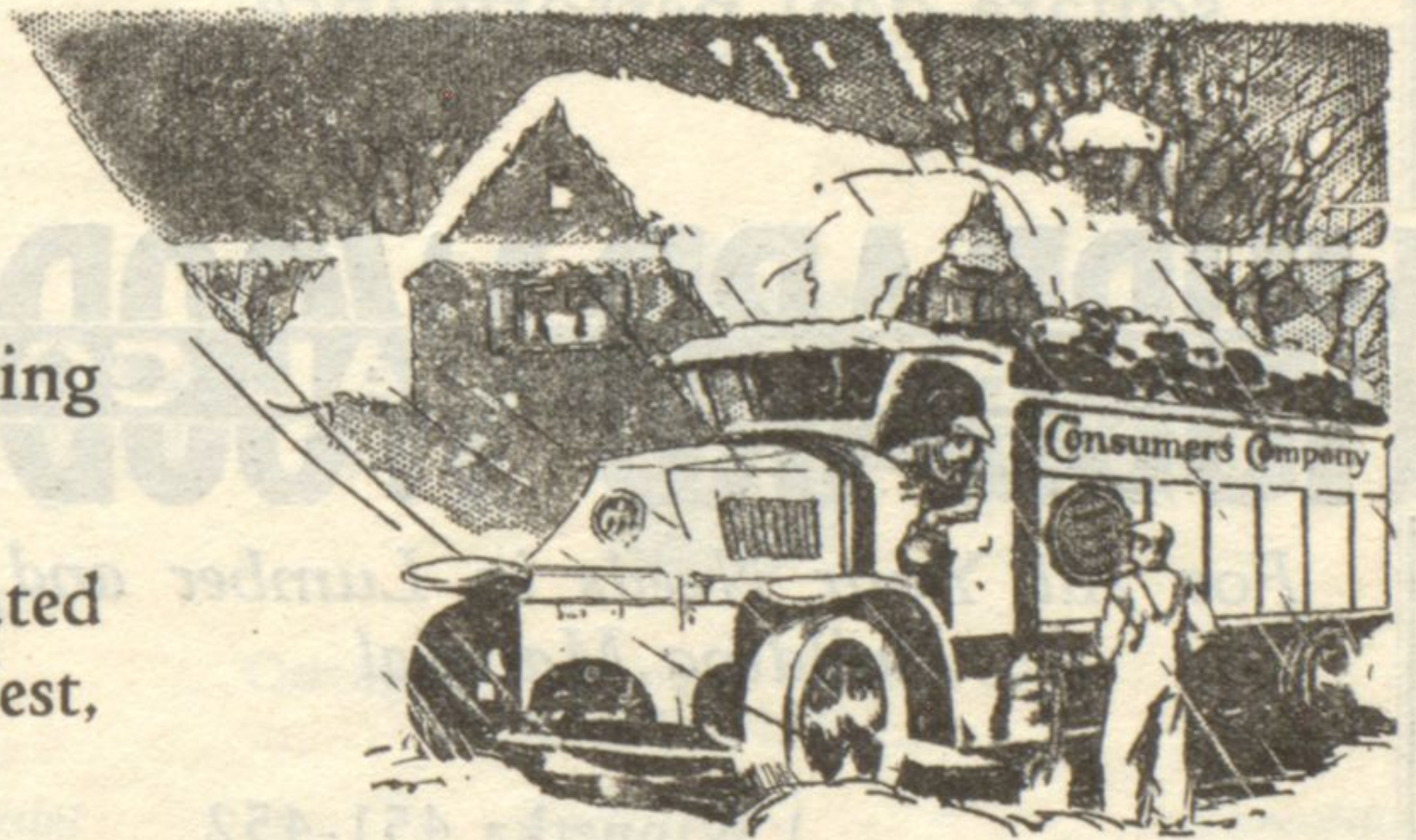
