New Trier Quintet Enters Basketball Meet at Waukegan

New Trier will be one of the contending teams in the district basketball tournament which is to be held at Waukegan the last three days of next week, March 10, 11 and 12. While not in the least over-confident, the boys are prepared to give all contenders a fast time and are expecting to be one of the two teams in the championship game Saturday night. The playing schedule has not as yet been received but entries have been sent in by Antioch, Arlington Heights, Deerfield Shields, Des Plaines, Evanston, Gurnee, Libertyville, Palatine, Wauconda and Waukegan.

The tournament promises to be one of the best cage exhibitions ever held in this part of the state. It is played under the auspices of the Illinois Athletic association and is one of a number of such meets being held all over the state. It will be played in the Waukegan gym which is said to be one of the finest in the middle west. Adequate seating facilities for well over 2,500 people are assured and the playing court measures 94 by 50 feet on a floor of 120 by 70 feet.

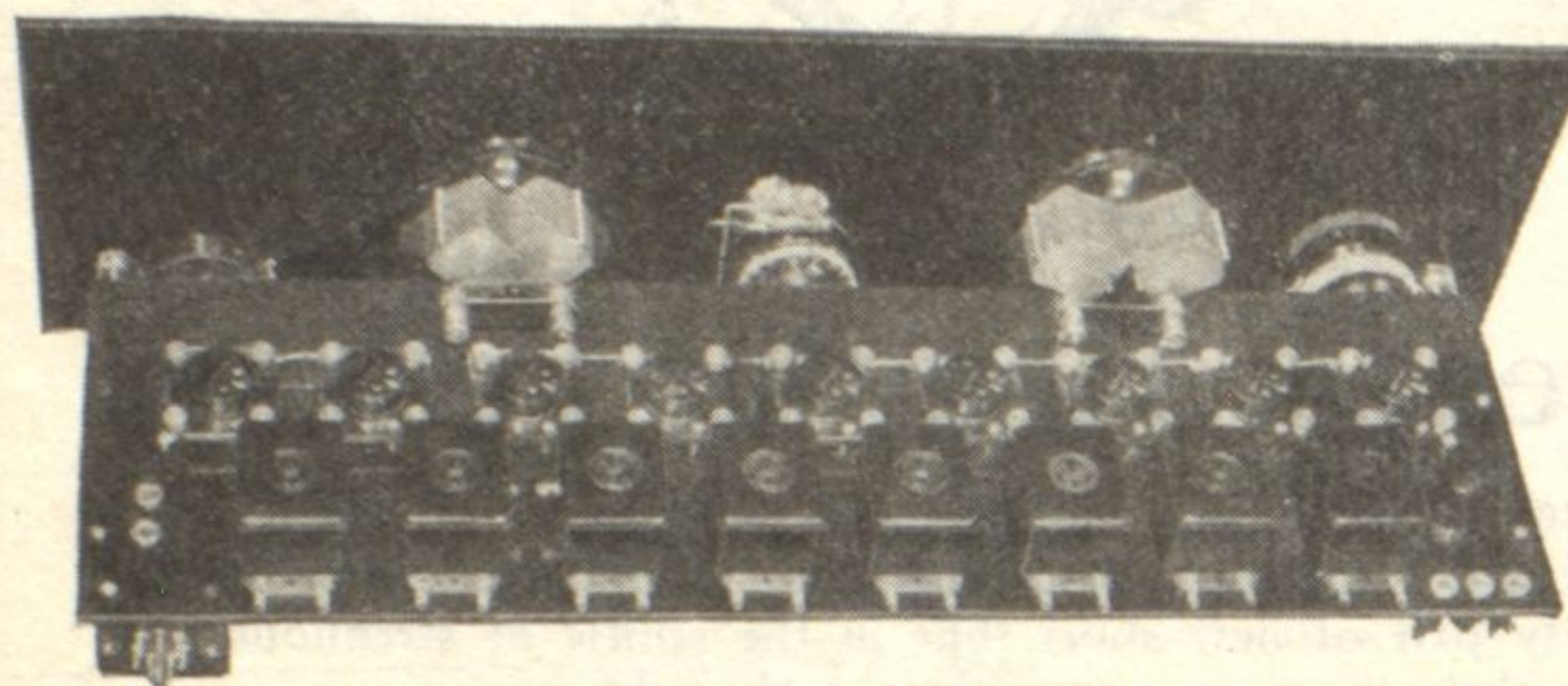
