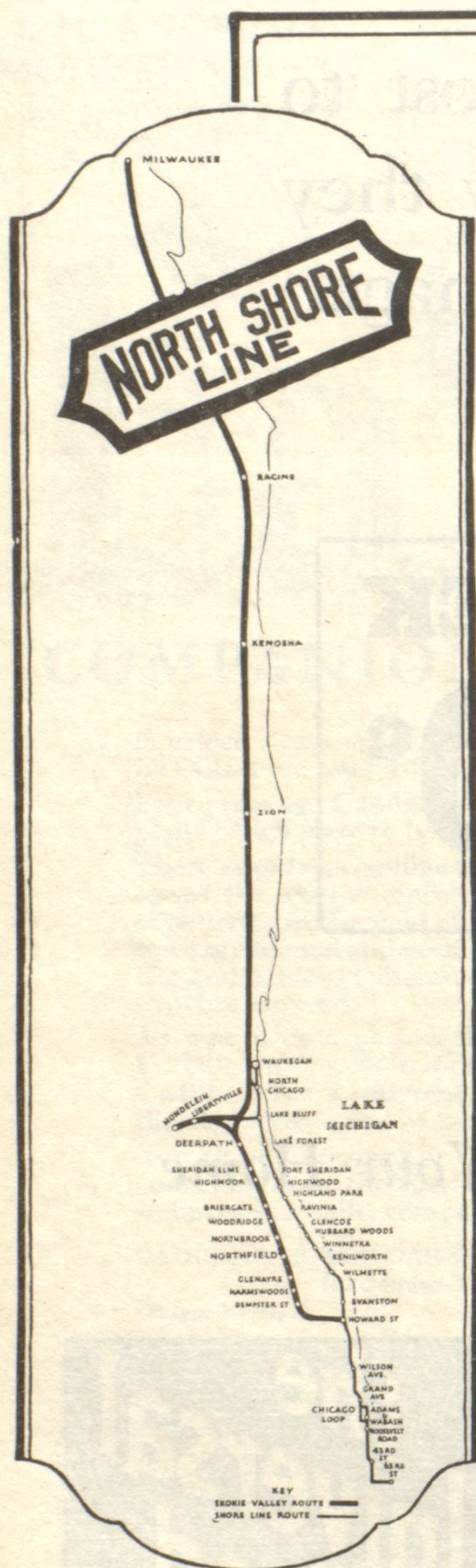
The other members of the People's party ticket are, Henry F. Miller, Richard Gould, and Ben Kirk, for the
