"Reality" was the subject of the  
 lesson-sermon in all Churches of  
 Christ, Scientist, Sunday, March 27.  
 The Golden Text was from Psalms  
 33:11, "The counsel of the Lord stand-

 Among the citations which compris-  
 ed the lesson-sermon was the following  
 from the Bible: "Brethren, I count

 the prize of the high calling of God

Late spring in Europe, early summer

 and Czecho-slovakia, and then join  
 friends to motor through Spain for a  
 month.

He is due June 20 at the State Uni-  
 versity of Montana where, with Aley  
 Burtis, who has done notable work  
 as production manager for the North  
 Shore Theater guild, he will direct  
 three courses in play production until  
 the first of August. The university is  
 also offering this summer a conference  
 on short story writing, to be directed  
 by Wilbur Daniels Steele, and its sum-  
 mer course and faculty include a num-  
 ber of valuable courses and interest-  
 ing people.

Mr. Dean was a member of the  
 faculty of this university when he first  
 left the professional theater. With  
 other members of the summer school  
 faculty he will make the trip to  
 Alaska before returning to Evanston  
 where he will continue with his free-  
 lancing in play direction and his writ-  
 ing. His first book, recently pub-  
 lished, on "Little Theater Organiza-  
 tion and Management," is being pub-  
 lished in England and is receiving fa-  
 vorable reviews there.

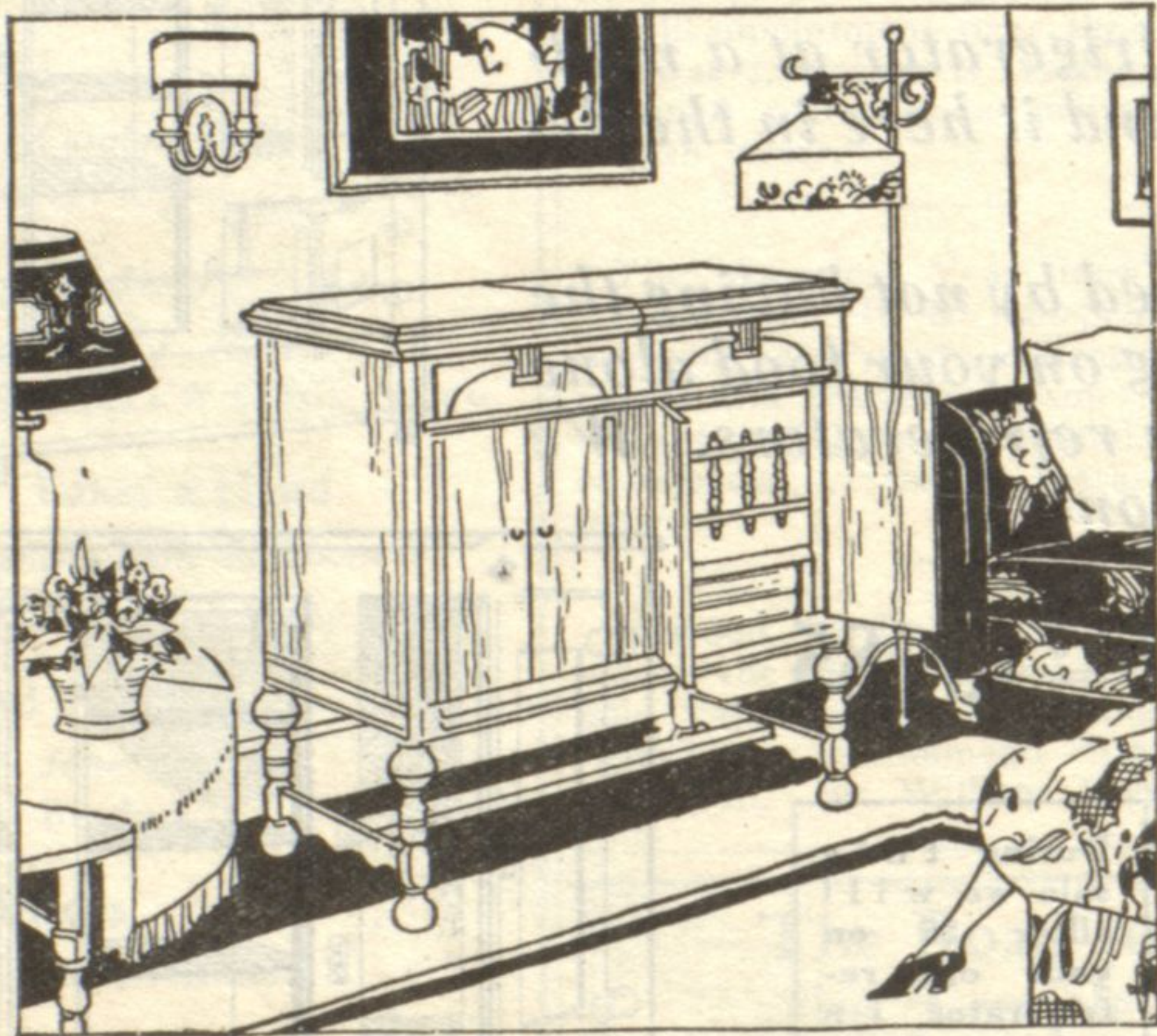

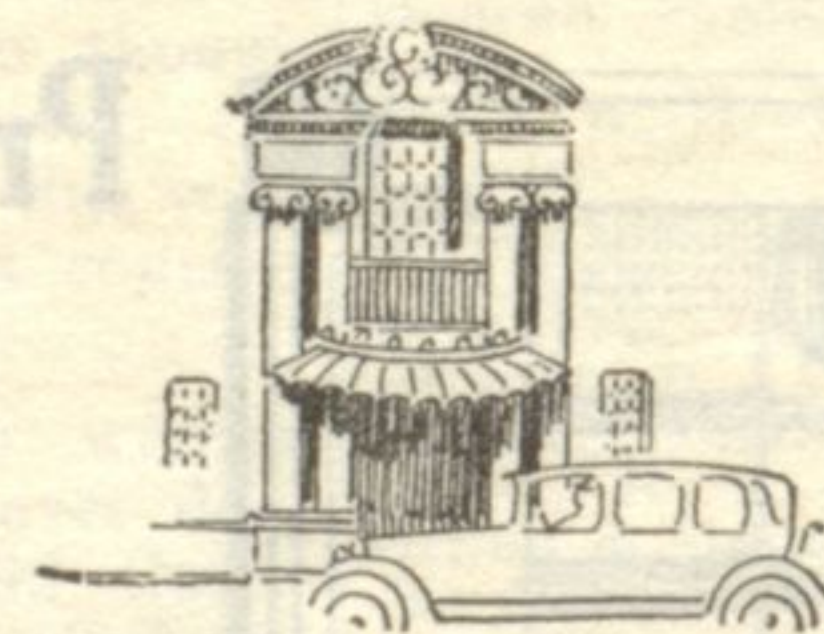
