The Wranglers, another non-Greek letter fraternity, were second, and the Scribblers of the same classification, were third. Then came Phi Kappa Psi with the best average made by them in recent years and the other Greek letter frats in close order. Phi Delta Theta and Phi Kappa Sigma were last on the list of the larger fraternities.

> Among the fraternities with less than ten undergratuate members on the scholarship list, Acacia led with an average of 1,487, an average scholarship grade that would place them third in the longer list of all fraternities. All men in fraternities averaged 1.148. Delta Mu led the sorority list with a point average of 1.812, then came Phi Omega Pi, Alpha Xi Delta and other sororities with averages only a little less. All girls in sororities averaged 1.471, or higher than the all-man average in the fraternities.
