Municipal Water Company Loses in Second Petition

The Illinois Commerce commission, in refusing the Municipal Water company a re-hearing recently, has definitely given its final approval to the Greater Chicago Lake Water company to go ahead with its plans to supply the suburbs within a radius of 38 miles of Chicago, with Lake water, according to officials of the Greater Chicago company. The latter company, which showed the Commerce body how comprehensive its \$35,000,000 plan was, received the permit to undertake the work on January 19. The Municipal Water company, which had appeared before the Illinois Commerce Commission as well, with a plan to take in a much smaller area, was given thirty days to petition for a re-hearing.

The Municipal Water company did this, it is explained, and now the state regulating body has announced that it has refused the re-hearing request, which gives its final approval to the Greater Chicago Lake Water company.

This company, of which R. J. Nash is president, A. J. Forschner, vicepresident, and Thomas J. Dolan of Chicago and Berwyn, secretary-treasurer, will build a giant water tunnel three miles into the lake. This tunnel will run direct to a main pumping station at Cicero, and the water will then be piped under high pressure to towns as far west as Aurora and Elgin, south to Chicago Heights and north to Lake Forest, northwest to Barrington and southwest to Joliet, including more than 100 towns and cities in the area. 


