The theatre will be allowed to run week days and the Clubs will be able to operate as the high-class organizations they claim to be. But Wilmette will police, will supervise and will regulate and restrict future "No-Man's Land" developments for their benefit as well as the community's. House Bill 51 will not raise taxes but will rather bring additional tax revenue from a source that now avoids taxation.
