### Experts to Comprise Scout Merit Faculty

"From forestry to plumbing, and poultry keeping to surveying" is the scope covered by the Vocational Merit Badge work of the Boy Scouts. Merit badges in seventy different vocations are provided, and men of these vocations are being secured as Merit Badge examiners.

When a Scout is prepared to be examined in the journalism merit badge, for instance, he reports to headquarters and is assigned to an examiner who is an expert in that field. The boy then arranges for an appointment, and appears for examination.

The Court of Honor committee, composed of Dr. C. B. Blake, J. R. Harper, N. L. Nygaard, W. J. McAllen, Frank Read and John Stryker, is building the list so that boys who are qualified may earn badges in any subject.

### Annual Bundle Day to Be Observed on North Shore May 4

The children of the north shore will co-operate with those of all Chicago and many suburban towns in observing Bundle Day, Wednesday, May 4, for the benefit of the needy orphans of the Holy Lands. This, right after "moving or house-cleaning day," is hailed as a boon to housewives, as well as practical charity.

It has been recognized and approved by the school authorities and department stores, whose trucks are donated to pick up bundles and take them to the central warehouse.

Bundle Day, conducted by Near East Relief for the thousands of children under their care, has had Chicago and vicinity's hearty support for several years. In 1926 over 500,000 pounds—eighteen carloads—of clothing was gathered together, made up into 1,845 bales and 1,640 bags and shipped promptly to the Near East. This year's indications point to an even greater total.

The refuges need all sorts of clothing—overcoats, jackets, trousers, long and short; coats, skirts, underclothing—and warm things especially as the Armenian climate is often severe. Donors are asked to omit shoes, hats, silks, but get everything else ready. Ask the principal, teachers or school children where the bundle stations are located.

If citizens cannot find a bundle station they are urged to send bundles to Near East Relief, 37 S. Wabash Ave., by parcel post. George M. Reynolds, prominent Chicago banker, is treasurer of Near East Relief, and Ex-Governor Frank O. Lowden is state chairman.
