

500 Knights Templar to Attend Inspection of Commandery Unit

Plans Big Dance

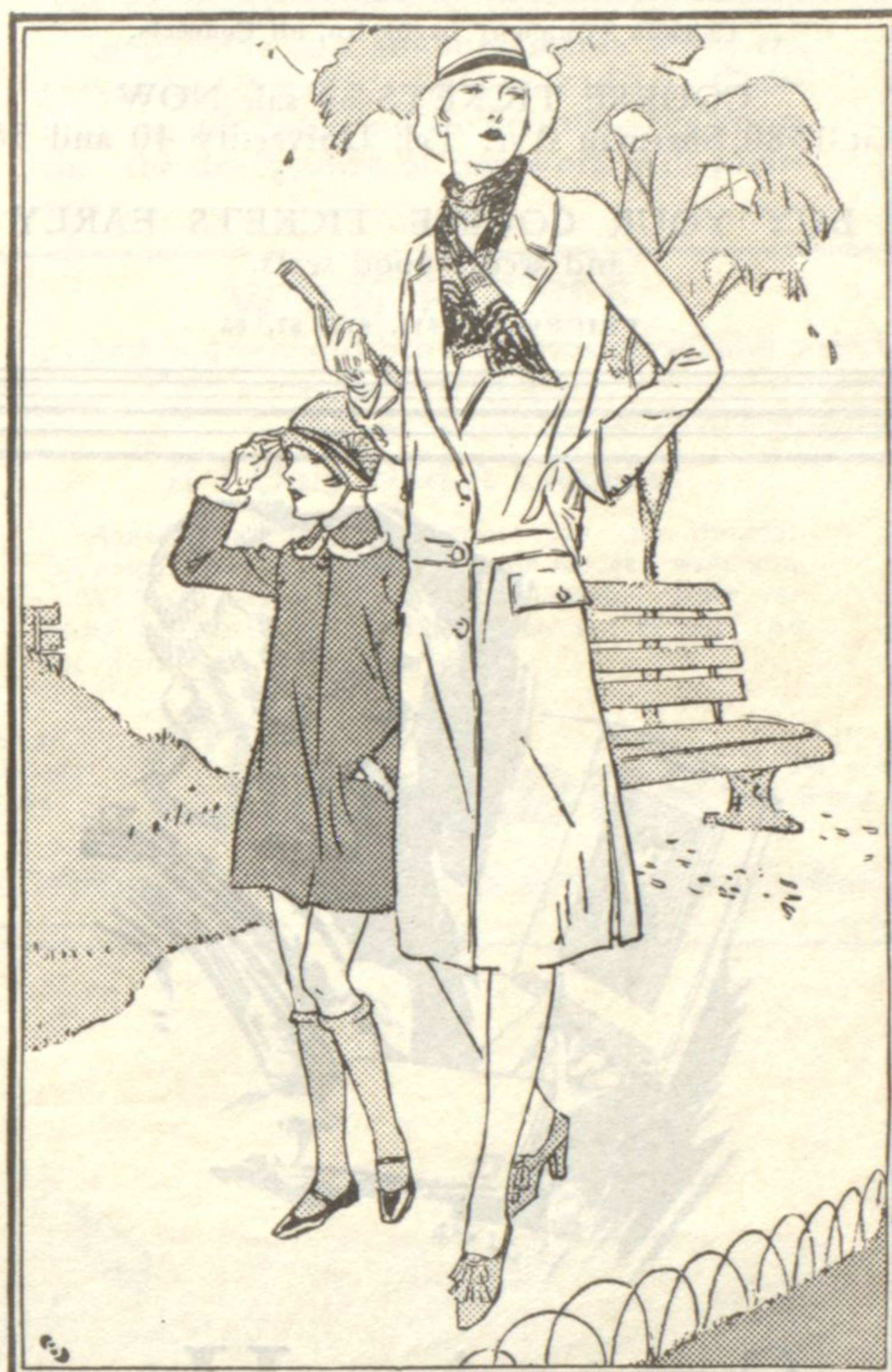

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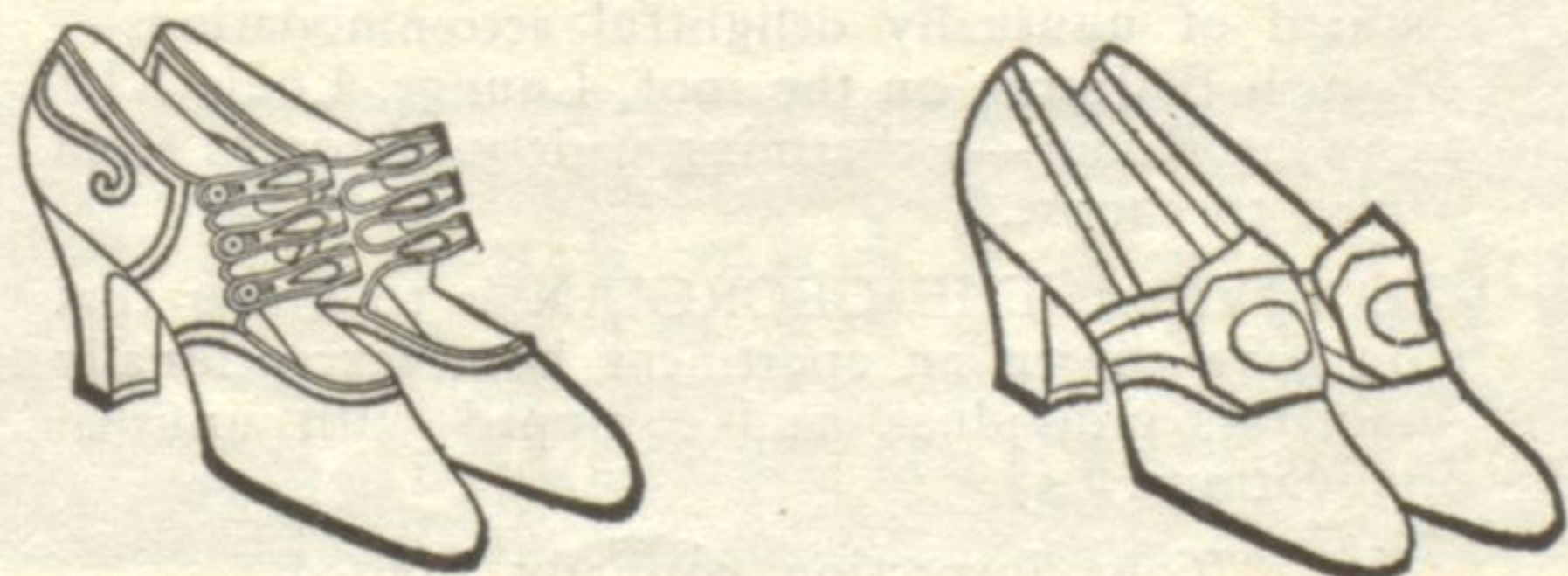
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
