

at the end of each year in the electric and water departments constitute the funds left after payment of operating expenses, depreciation replacements, and capital outlays for providing the necessary added capacity to handle the estimated increase in demand. Revenues of the water department, used for arriving at the surplus in the water department, assume that the Glencoe contract will be terminated in 1928-9, and expenditures for plant additions in the water department are based on the assumption that it will not be necessary to carry the Glencoe load after April 1, 1928.


