

**Winnetka Beaches
Formally Opened
to Public Today**

The Winnetka public beaches formally open today.

H. F. Tenney, village president, has issued the following announcement regarding public streets ending at Lake Michigan.

"New residents of the village are informed that the following streets extend east of Sheridan road to Lake Michigan and are open to the public for access to the lake shore:

"Tower road, Spruce street, Elm street, Oak street, Cherry street and Willow street.

"It has been necessary to adopt the following police regulations in order to control the large crowds of pleasure seekers outside the village:

"1. No bathing nor picnicking is allowed at street ends.

2. Parking of cars on Sheridan road and at street ends east of Sheridan road is not allowed.

"For the present, the regulation regarding bathing and picnicking at street end sections of the beach will not be enforced rigidly in the case of Winnetka residents, as it is desired to extend the privileges of the streets and beaches to our own citizens to the fullest extent, without inviting an influx of outside crowds.

"It is requested, however, that Winnetka residents use the public beaches at Lake Front park and Elder Lane park as much as possible and observe strictly the rule regulating parking of cars on Sheridan road and at street ends, east of Sheridan road."

**Building Permits Reach
\$2,651,620 in Past Year**

Building permits totalling \$2,651,620 were issued in Winnetka during the fiscal year ending March 31, according to statistics just completed in the department of the building inspector A. B. Kreig. There were a total of 245 permits, 109 of which were for residences costing \$1,809,600; 88 are listed as accessories, totalling \$43,170; 27, commercial, \$532,500 and 21, alterations, \$266,350. During the year 82 cases were referred to the board of appeals for consideration and decision.
