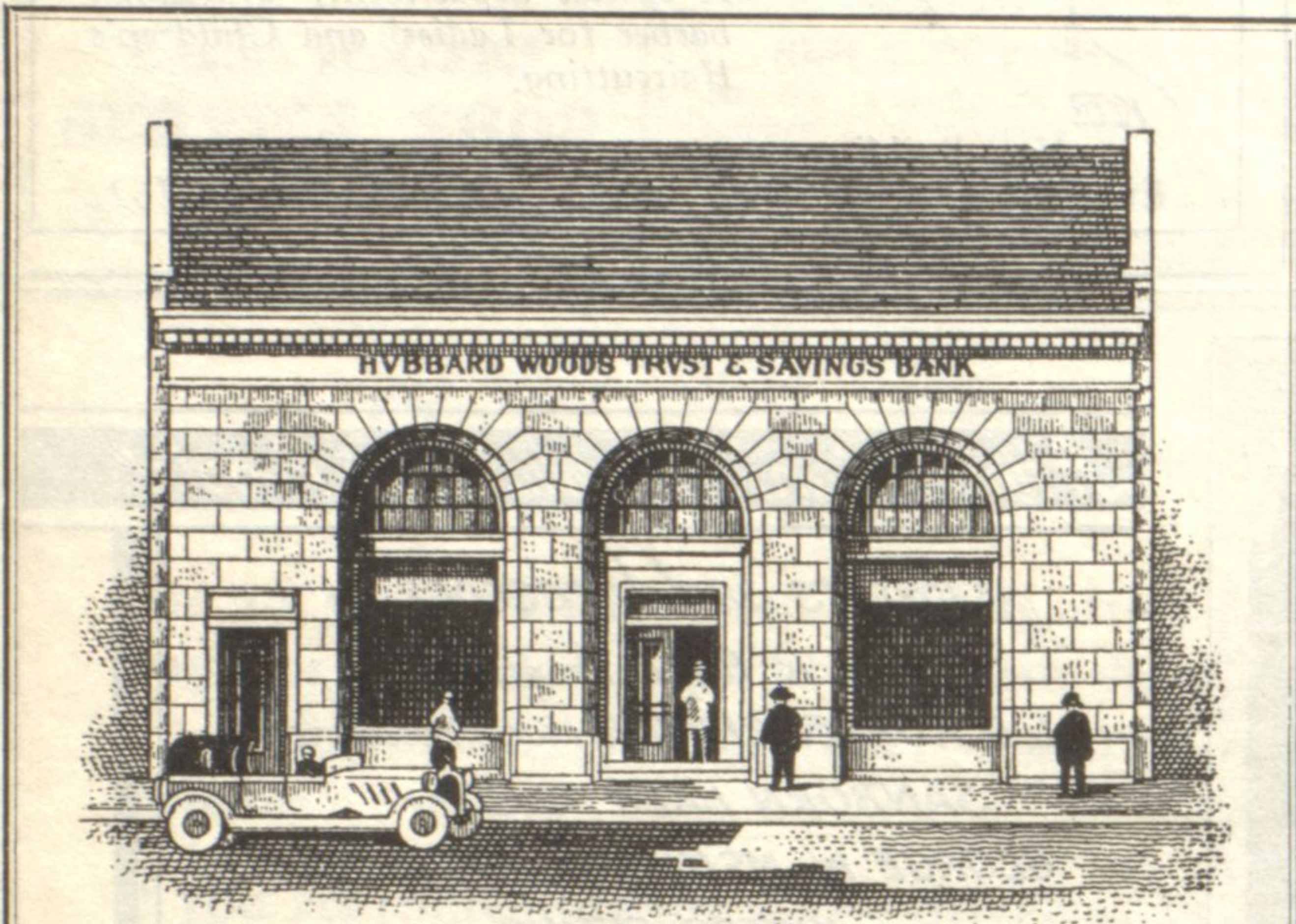

ported from the west under certain weather conditions.

Householders can be of great assistance in helping to eliminate breeding places by keeping gutters and downspouts free of standing water and by grading and filling property so that water does not stand for more than a maximum of two or three days. All bird baths should be syphoned out at least once every ten days and fish ponds should be stocked with minnows.

Spraying Ineffective

It should be understood that mosquitoes must have water in which to breed. Spraying of trees and shrubs to kill mosquitoes on the wing is useless, and often much unnecessary damage results.

Complaints regarding breeding places observed about the village will be gladly received at the Village hall, and will receive prompt attention.

Winnetka Booklet Under Consideration by C. of C.

The matter of issuing a booklet on Winnetka, which has been under consideration by the Chamber of Commerce, was again discussed at the meeting of that body Monday evening, at which time it was referred to a committee of which Vic Killian is chairman.
