

Frank A. Reid in Many Realty Deals in Glencoe Area

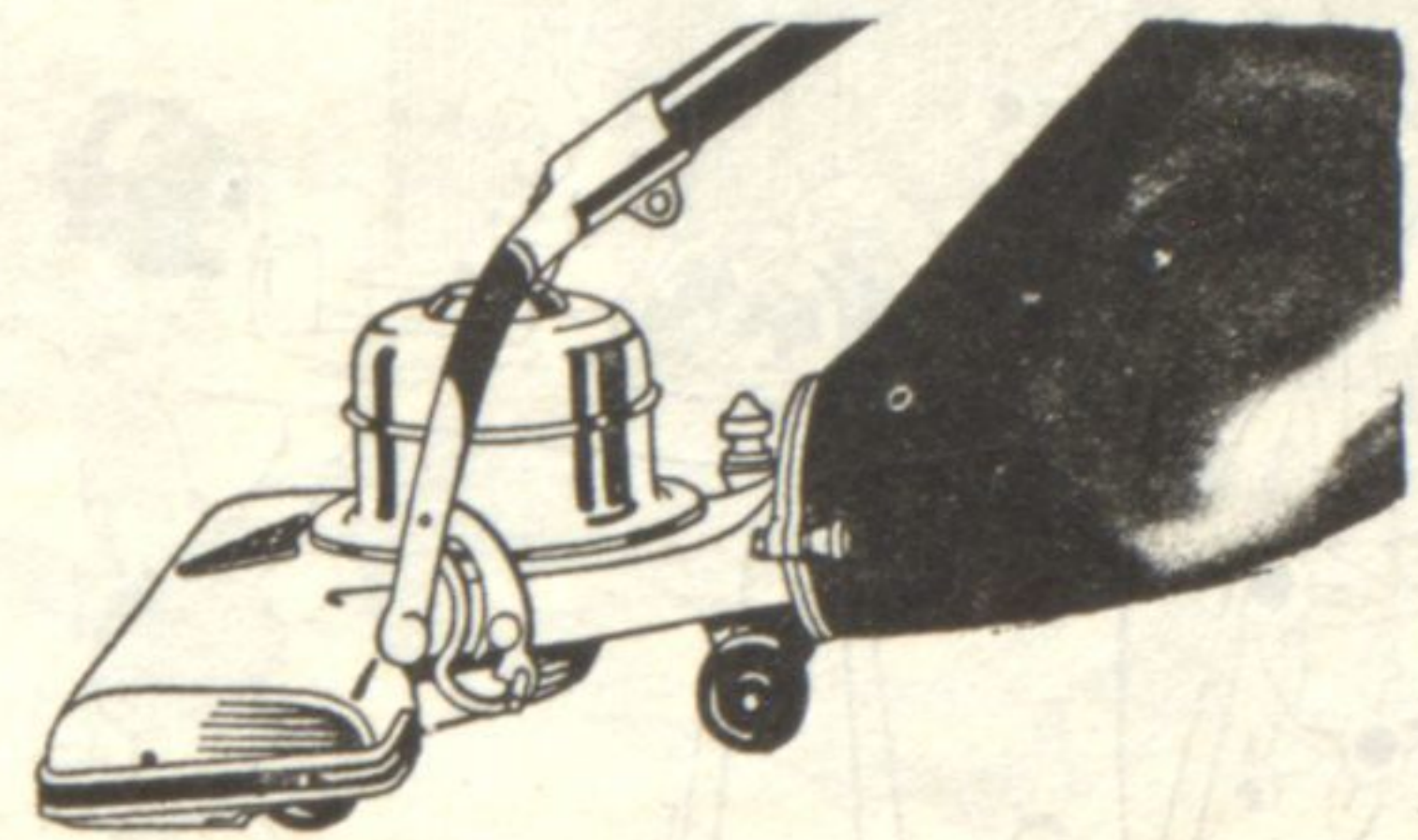
