277 SENIORS TAKE PART IN N. T. COMMENCEMENT

Rev. John Timothy Stone to Address Graduating Class at High School Tonight

Commencement exercises at New Trier High school were held last evening in the auditorium of the school. Two hundred and seventy-seven seniors participated in the program, which was featured by an address, "The Winning of the Crescent," by Rev. John Timothy Stone.

While there were 277 students participating in the exercises, only 245 received their certificates at this time; 32 having certain required work to complete which will be disposed of during the summer session. In addition to these there are also 11 pupils who completed their work in February and received their diplomas at the program last night.

The Rev. Horace G. Smith of the Wilmette Parish Methodist church will give the invocation, and the Rev. Thomas A. Goodwin of the Winnetka Congregational church, the benediction. The president of the senior class, Fred C. Hoerber, represented the class of 1927 in the program. The president of the school board, Harry C. Holloway of Glencoe, gave out the diplomas to the graduates, who were presented by Frederick E. Clerk.

Henry P. Williams presented the English prizes for this year. They are awarded for poetry and essay writing. The music for the evening was: piano duet, Lois Hammet and Harriet Mons; vocal solo, Catherine Bickman; piano solo, Jane Young.
