### To Sell Needlework at Eli Bates Shop June 23

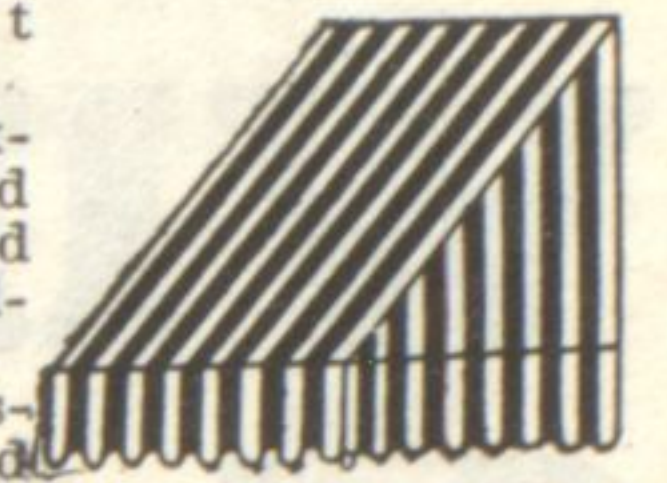
