**TO TOUR HOLY LAND**

**Rev. Francis Carr Stifler in Last Sermon Sunday Prior to Extended Tour of Foreign Countries**

Rev. Francis Carr Stifler, pastor of the Wilmette Baptist church will preach his final sermon prior to an extended tour of the Holy Land, at the services of that church Sunday morning, June 26. Mr. Stifler will sail from New York on the steamship Homeric in company with a large group of church workers from various parts of the country. Following a tour of the Holy Lands, the party will visit London, Paris, Egypt, Constantinople, Greece and Italy.

Arriving at Southampton, the travelers will spend four days in England, making an automobile tour of London, the Shakespeare country, and other places within easy reach of the capital. Three days will be spent in Paris and the departure for Palestine will be made from Marseilles on July 19.

After a voyage through the Mediterranean, arriving in Alexandria on July 24, the party will visit Cairo, and the tomb of Tut-Ankh-Amen, and spend one afternoon gazing at the Pyramids and the Sphinx. Jerusalem will be reached on July 26 and the following week will be spent in the Holy Land. August 3 and 4 will be made by sea to Piraeus and Athens and through the Straits of Messina to Naples, and thence back to Marseilles and Paris.

The tour is to be made under auspices of the Church Touring guild.
