MYSTERY SURROUNDS DEATH OF SANDWICK

said to have stated that the car had given considerable trouble throughout the day, necessitating repeated stopping for adjustment.

According to the police, blood and other marks indicated that Sandwich had been struck by the lower part of the Dennehy machine and not by a fender in a side swiper. Moreover, the body was found some ten feet away from the parked car. These facts and Carter's testimony are considered sufficient by the police to substantiate the later theory. Inasmuch as relatives and friends state that he never drank and no indications of alcoholism were found, the theory that Sandwich had become ill is considered the more likely. A report that witnesses to the accident had been found was scouted by the police, since it was unlikely that anyone viewing the situation would have gone on without stopping to give aid to the injured man.

Sandwich was a student at Leland Stanford university and was home on vacation.

Permits Issued for Three Homes Valued at \$35,500

Three permits were issued by the Village of Winnetka during the past week, authorizing the erection of three residences, the total cost of which will approximate \$35,500.

Two of the permits were issued to George F. Gonsalves of Winnetka on Tuesday. The first was for a two and a half story brick veneer home with attached garage which will be erected at 914 Essex road, at a cost of \$12,000. The second was for another two and a half story brick veneer residence with attached garage at 350 Winnetka avenue, the cost of which will be about \$9,000.

The third permit was issued for the construction of a residence at 1350 Asbury avenue which will cost in the neighborhood of \$14,500.
