Among the citations which comprised the Lesson-Sermon was the following from the Bible: "I will love thee, O Lord, my strength. For who is God save the Lord? or who is a rock save our God?" (Psalms 18:1, 2, 31).

Visions Church News as Big Thing in Journalism

Rapping "Elmer Gantry," the Rev. John T. Brabner Smith of Evanston, reporting at the annual meeting of the World Service Commission of the Methodist Episcopal church, held recently in Chicago, said:

"Some day church news and church editors will be the big thing in journalism. If a story on a brilliant and dirty preacher sells by thousands, how much more would a serial story of a saint of God in modern literature interest the readers of the public press.

"The newspaper," he said, "is the best and surest medium of advertising and for publicity of the church because it goes into practically every home regardless of race or creed. Weekly and daily newspapers are giving the churches and church news much space. Less of sensationalism and more constructive news is the demand of city and country journalism. The churches must provide it in acceptable style and form."

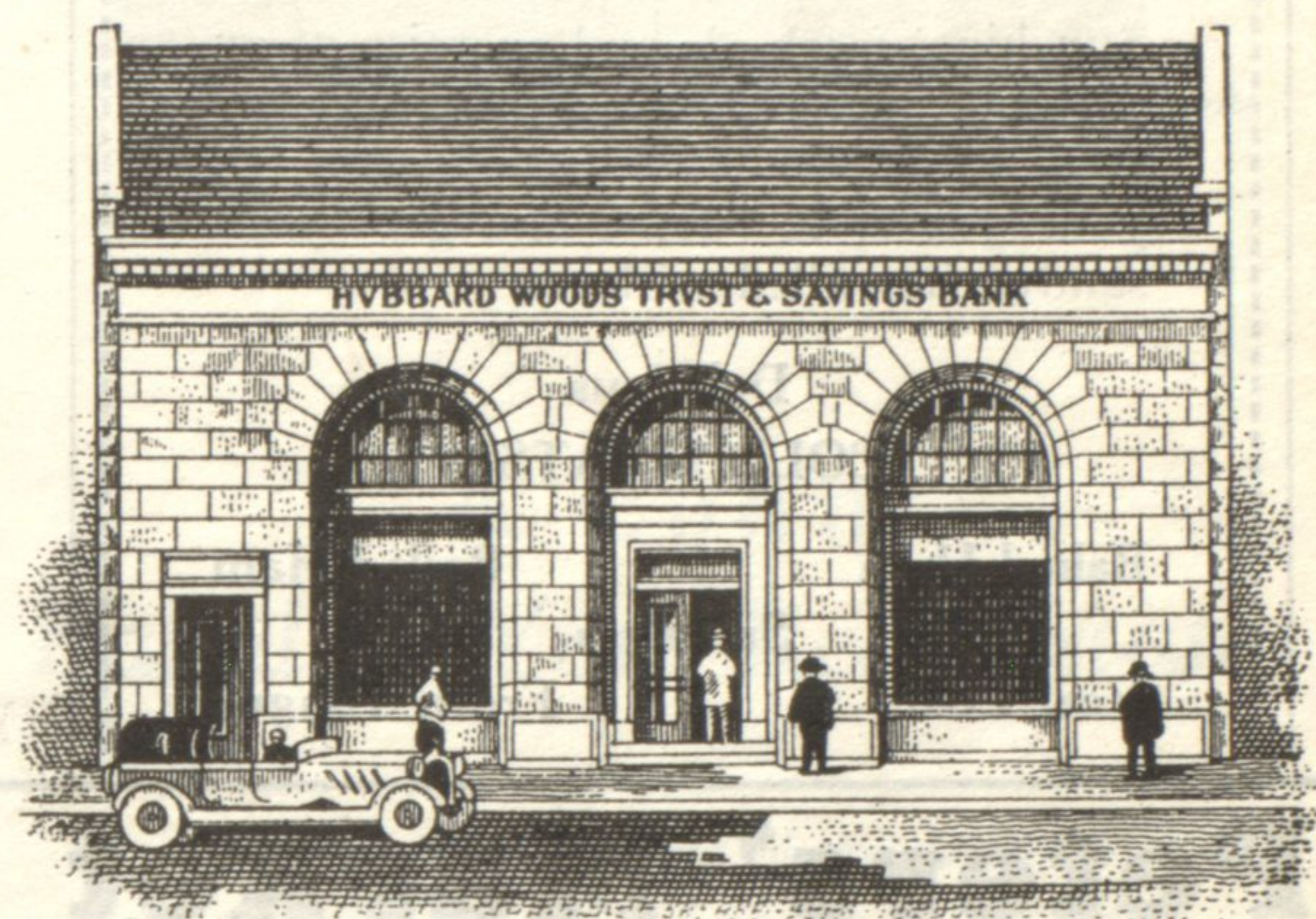
