

### Man's Destiny Points to High Spiritual Plane

Man is so adaptable and is capable of such rapid evolution that no one has the right to declare he can not develop from his present condition, part physical and part spiritual, to a higher plane where the spirit will be supreme. So indicated Dr. Franklin D. Baker, head of the zoology department of Northwestern university, in an address this week in Harris Hall, Evanston campus, before Northwestern summer students and the public. His lecture was on the theme "The Destiny of Man," and was illustrated.

"The philosopher generally consigns man to oblivion, the theologian to heaven or hell," said Dr. Baker. "Is there any scientific evidence as to the destiny of man?"

#### Scientific Philosophy of Life

"The open minded study of animals and animal life reveals many facts and principles that are exceedingly suggestive and helpful in formulating a philosophy of life that is scientific and at the same time inspiring. Some of the observable outstanding and fundamentally important facts in the study of animal life are the plasticity or adaptability of living things and their almost infinite potentiality. These are evident in the varied morphological patterns that the same structure may assume as the fore-leg, arm and wing. That such seemingly different structures are but adaptations and modifications of a common structure is strikingly proven by the illuminating study of their development or embryology.

"Man stands supreme in animal creation due to the unusual development of his brain. All other animals are more or less the slaves of their environment and man alone is free for his creative mind has given him the mastery. He is the arbiter of his destiny.

"The marvelous brain of man had a very humble beginning as shown in a comparative study of the nervous systems and brains of lower animals.

#### Undreamed of Possibilities

"From brainless lower animals,

step by step, through centralization, concentration headward, and cortical enlargement, man's brain has evolved. Of the ninety-two hundred million nerve cells in the cerebral cortex and their infinite possible combinations, the half is not known and their latent possibilities undreamed of.

"The method of development and the latent potentiality of the human brain are the unmistakable marks that clearly indicate the road that man is traveling to a definite destiny.

"The activity or functioning of the brain mechanism gives rise to mind and its supreme product constitutes the soul. Man is inseparably body, mind and spirit. As man's mental or psychic nature has evolved from, and is gaining the mastery over his animal or physical nature, so his spiritual nature is evolving from his psychic nature and will eventually dominate both his animal and mental natures and he will attain his destiny, a spiritual being."

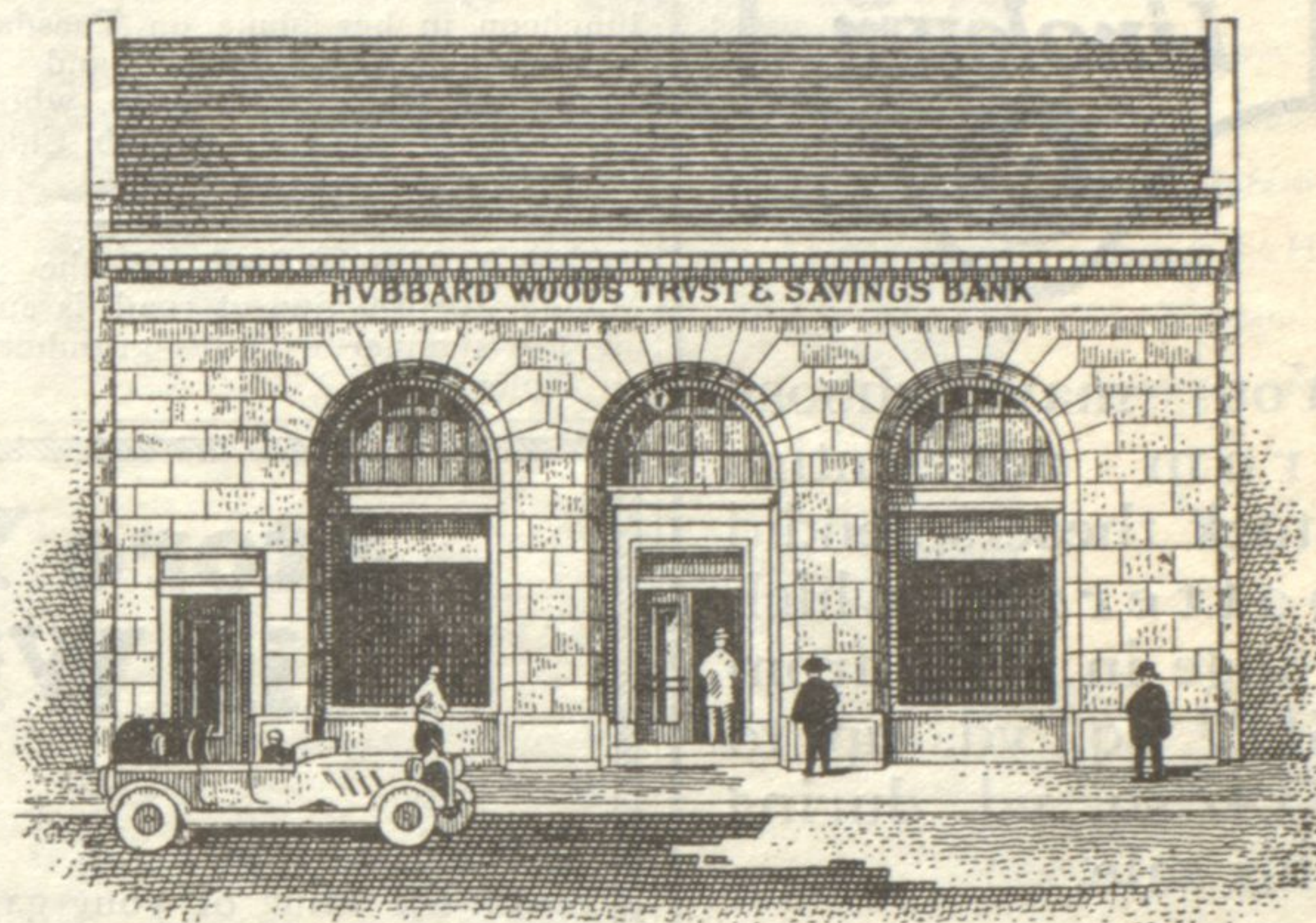
