

WILL TEACH COACHES

Athletic Mentors from Colleges and High Schools Will Study Football, Basketball, Swimming on Campus

For ten days, beginning August 17, a group of high school and college coaches and aspirants from all over the Middle West will study football, basketball and swimming coaching at Northwestern university's first summer coaching school.

Dick Hanley, Purple football mentor, is to be in charge of the grid course; Tom Robinson, dean of American tank coaches, who has nine times brought to Northwestern the Big Ten title since 1914, will give an intensive course in swimming and life saving, and Arthur Lonberg, head basketball coach at Northwestern, assisted by Ted Payseur, will conduct classes in basketball. Kenneth L. Wilson, athletic director, will conduct a course in the theory and organization of athletic departments.

Supplementary lectures on football will be given by Coach Jess Hawley of Dartmouth, Judge Walter Steffens, head coach at Carnegie Tech; Duke Dunne, line coach at Harvard, and John Schommer, Western Conference football and basketball official.

Coach Hanley will be assisted in class work by his brother and chief aide, Pat Hanley; Tim Lowry, former All-Western center, and Herb Steger, assistant coach at Northwestern and former Michigan captain.
