### Junior Dramatics Class Presents Two Playlets

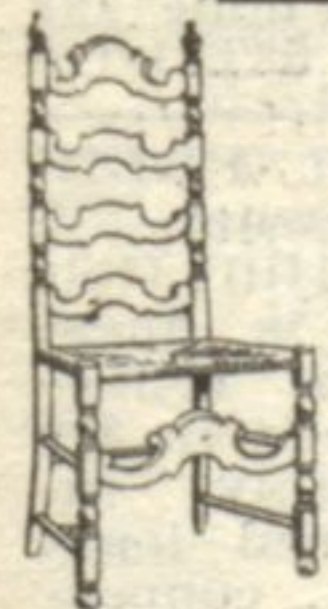

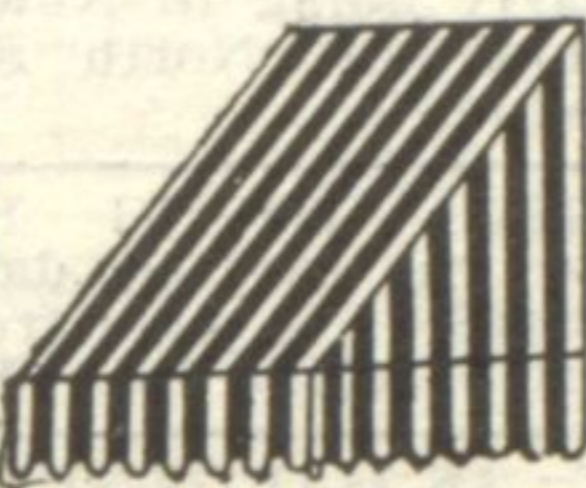
The building is being erected at a cost of about \$10,000 and is in keeping with the many other pretty homes which are rapidly dotting this section.
