Illinois holds third place in the manufacture of paper bags exclusive of those made in paper mills. Three plants employ 378 persons; salaries and wages, \$417,000; value of products, \$3,887,000 yearly. First and second place go to New York and Ohio respectively.

**County Regulates Flying
by Set of New Measures**

The Cook County board has taken the bull by the horns so far as regulation of aviation in Cook county is concerned by adopting a program of activity which will protect the lives and property of Cook county citizens. The official acts performed by the County board with regard to this subject were as follows:

Revocation of all flying permits in the Forest Preserve district.

Instruction to the Law department of the Forest Preserve district to create a code of ordinances regulating all flying in or above the Forest Preserve district.

Granting that jurisdiction to the Cook County Highway department of regulating all flying fields of a commercial nature on Cook county highways.

**Would Eliminate
Grade Crossings
in Cook County**

The Cook County Board of Commissioners Thursday, July 28, launched a drive against dangerous grade crossings in Cook county, when it inaugurated at the suggestion of President A. J. Cermak, a bureau of grade crossing separation.

The appalling record of deaths at grade crossings in Cook county has called for definite action by the legislative body of the county and Major George A. Quinlan, superintendent of highways, has pursued an investigation over the county hard roads system and the proposed new \$15,000,000 road system. It has been determined that there are two hundred and seventy grade crossings, and working at top speed these grade crossings should be separated in three years.

So that this might be done, President Cermak has recommended the inauguration of a bureau which will do nothing else but confine its attention to the legal and engineering problems which will be confronted in the effort to protect the lives of the automobile public of Cook county.

Under the plan this bureau will be a part of the Highway department, and will be expected to set up a record of one hundred grade crossings separated each year for the next three years.

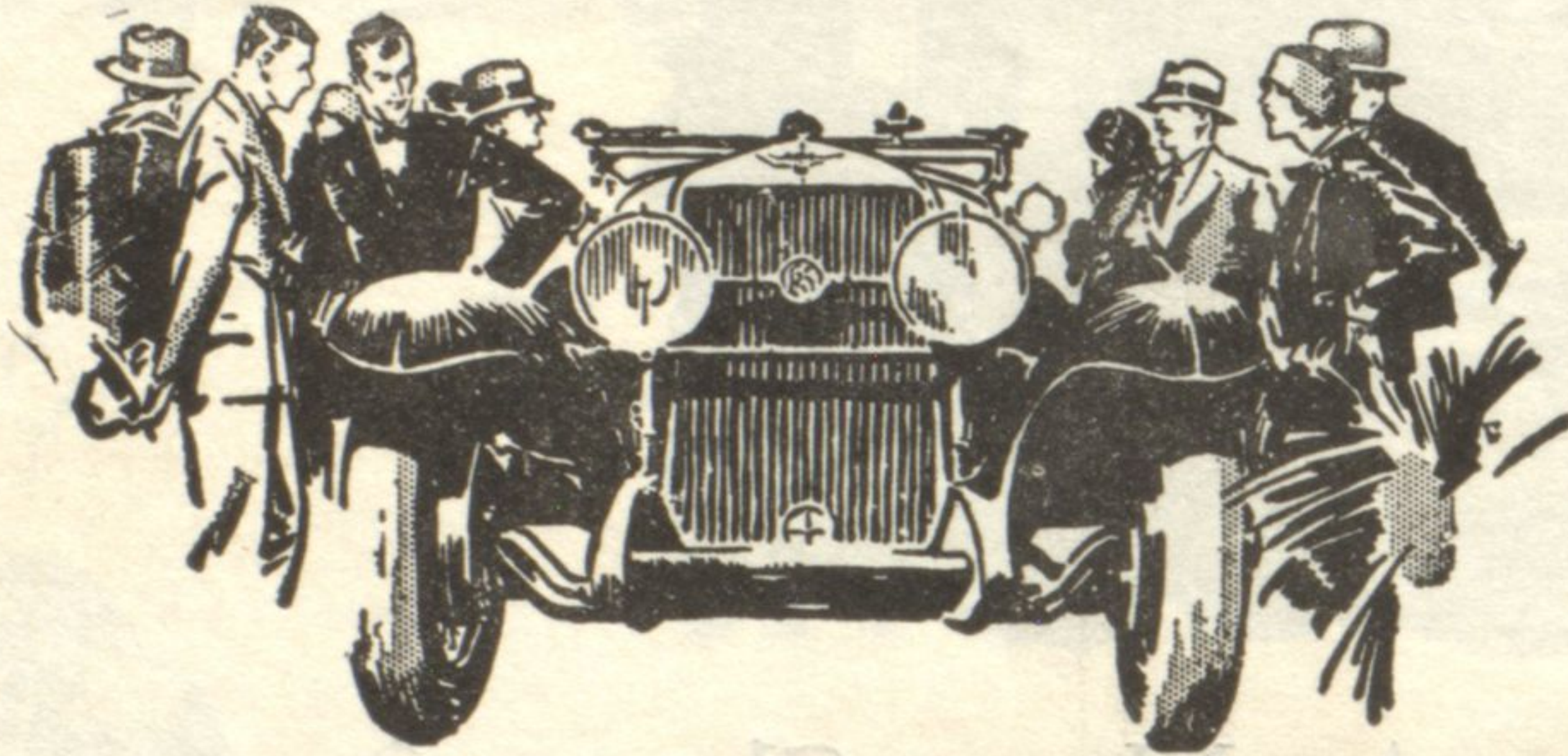

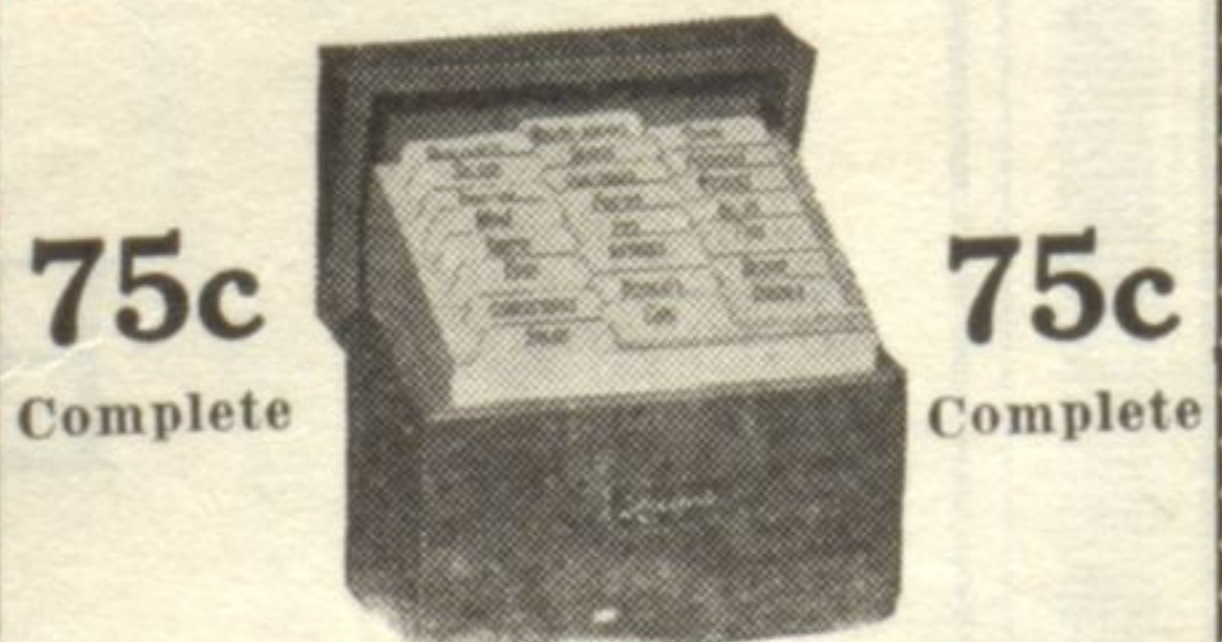
