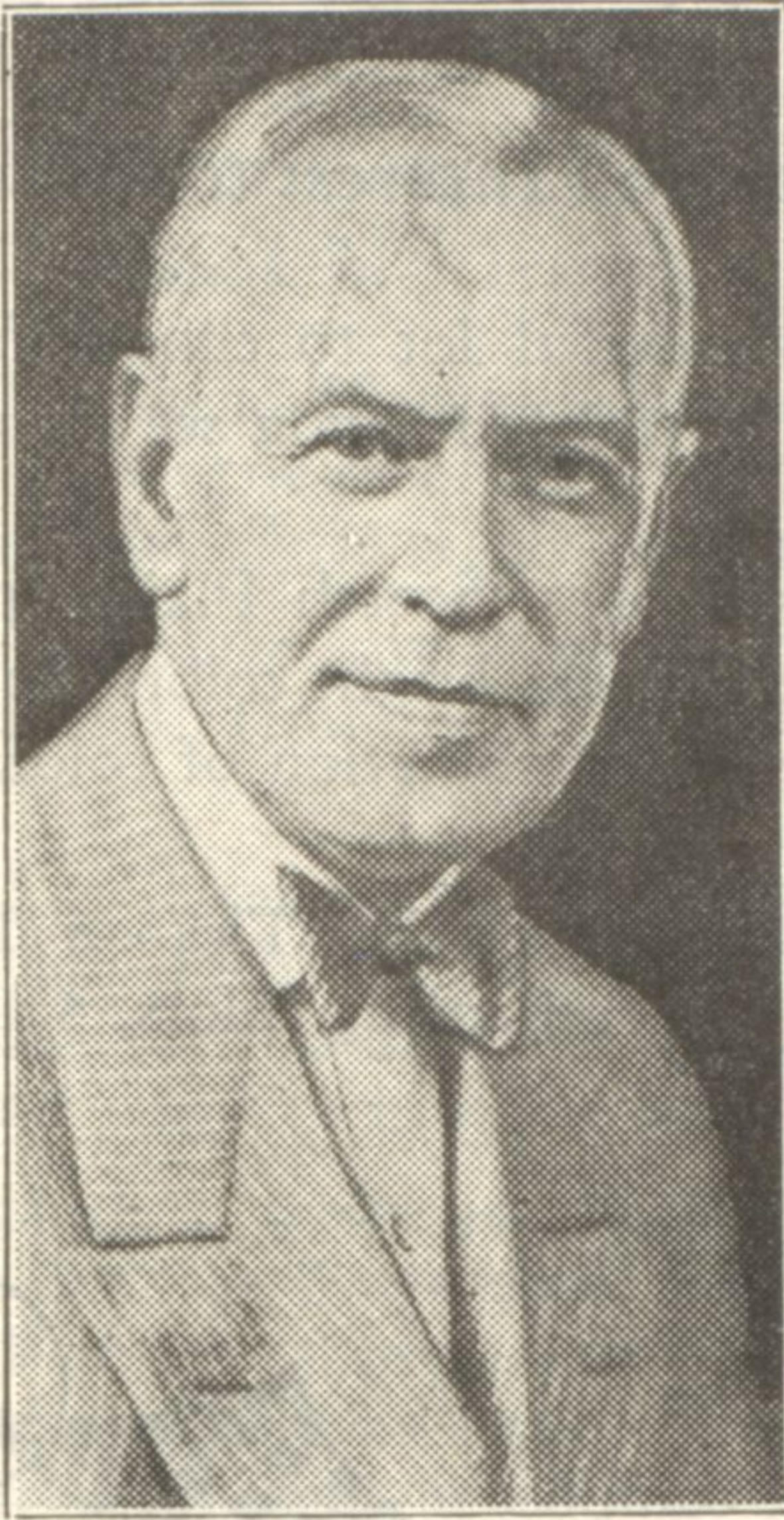

Arthur Stringer Resigns as Anti-Mosquito Director

Arthur Stringer who, as associate director of the Gorgas Memorial Institute, has been in direct charge of the anti-mosquito activities in the Chicago Metropolitan district for the past two and one half years, announced his resignation, effective August 1, 1927.

During Mr. Stringer's connection with the Gorgas Memorial it has come to be known nationally as an authority on matters of individual health and locally as the champion of mosquito victims, as well. The signing of the

anti-mosquito bill by Gov. Len Small on July 7, which is making it possible for suburban communities to organize, legally, mosquito abatement districts, was the result of the work of education and organization carried on by Mr. Stringer.

"It is a distinct pleasure to have been of public service to the people of Chicago," said Mr. Stringer today, "and inasmuch as legislative work has been accomplished, I feel that withdrawal at this time will not impede the program of the Institute."
