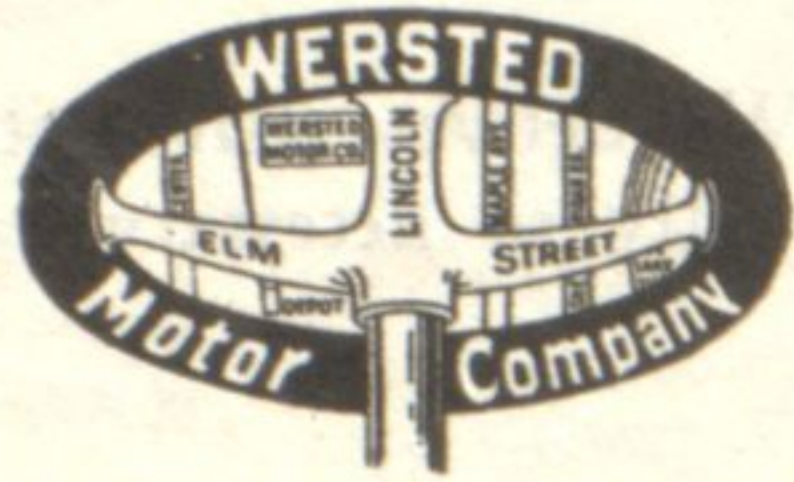


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## KNEPPER A PAR GOLFER IN WESTMORELAND MEET

### Tops Huge Field in Opening Play of Annual Tam o'Shanter Tourney, Scoring 71

Rudy Knepper of Onwentsia, who has been shooting great golf this season, stepped over to the Westmoreland course Wednesday and in the first day's play of the annual Tam o'Shanter tournament gave an exhibition of par playing that left a number of other stars stringing along many strokes behind.

It was the twelfth Tam o'Shanter—the annual invitation event—held by Westmoreland, the field being so large that it was late at evening before the final scores had been tabulated.

Knepper's effort and his score for the first eighteen holes of the tourney was 71. Another guest, Al Seckel of Riverside, the same Al Seckel, who a few years ago cut quite a swath in Chicago golf, came back to land second place in the play for low gross honors. Seckel turned in a 74 card.
