

Despite the fact that in former seasons the local beaches have been closed immediately following Labor Day, due to the intense heat wave which has been in evidence throughout the north shore the local beaches will remain open until cool weather warrants their closing, it was announced this week. Should the weather again turn warm after that time, the beach guards will again be placed on duty but the beach house will remain closed until next season.

Approximately 2,000 residents sought relief from the heat last Wednesday and took to the beaches for "coolness' sake." On the previous day more than 1,500 people attended the local watering place. Throughout the week picnic parties and other bathers were in evidence almost in the largest numbers that have been recorded at any time during the season.
