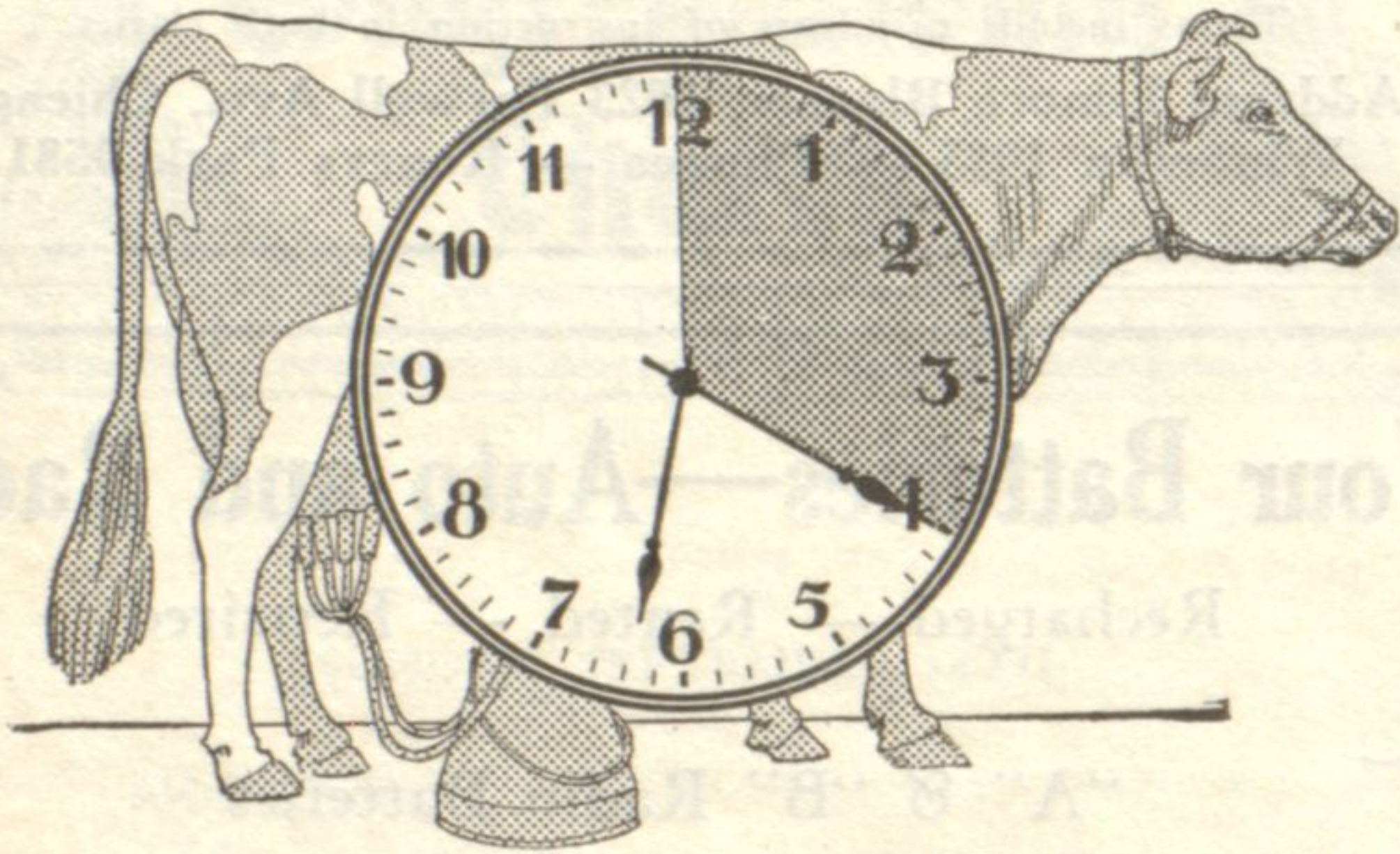

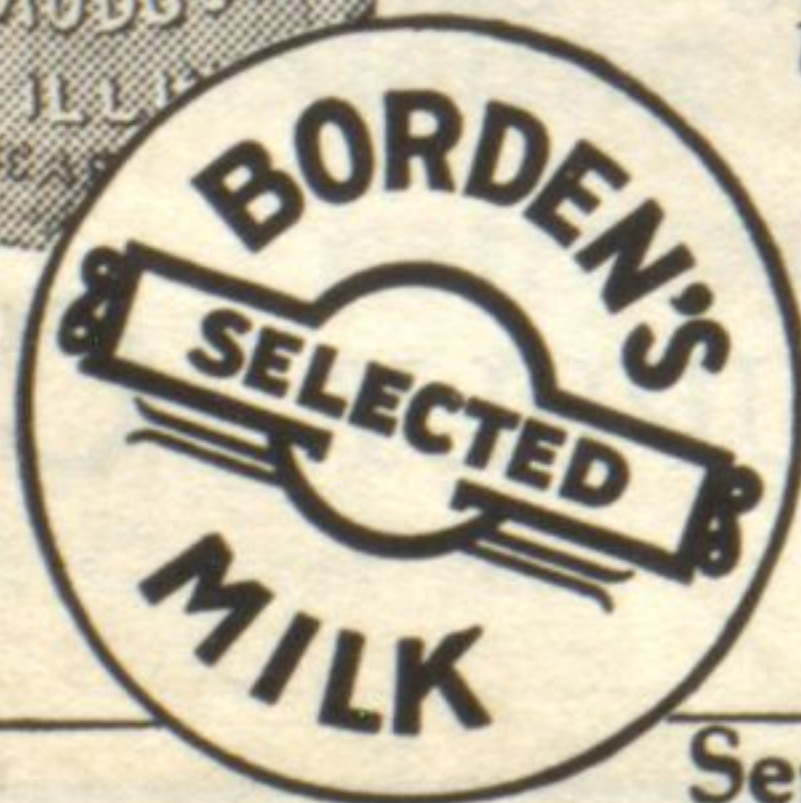

Scouts to Be Guests at Purple-South Dakota Game

More than 600 Boy Scouts of the North Shore Area council will be the guests of Northwestern university at the opening game of the football season which will be played with South Dakota at Dyche stadium on Saturday, October 1. The north shore boys will be a part of the contingency of 4,000 Scouts from troops within a radius of 50 miles of Chicago who have been invited to attend the game by Max Hayford, ticket manager for the university.

The Scouts are asked to meet at Central street, Evanston at 1 o'clock on the afternoon of the game, and to be in uniform. They will form in troops under the direction of their own leaders and will march with the Evanston Scouts to the field, it was announced by Scout Executive Walter McPeck.

Mothers' Classes at N. K. E. C. Begin Sessions Tuesday

The classes for mothers, which were conducted so successfully last year by the National Kindergarten and Elementary college, will be continued this fall. During the first semester President Edna Dean Baker will conduct a "Conference on Behavior Problems," meeting in Harrison hall at 10:30 o'clock on Tuesday mornings, beginning Tuesday, September 26. The course, if satisfactorily completed, carries one full semester hour of college credit.

The enrollment last year included fifty-six mothers from Wilmette, Winnetka, Evanston and Rogers Park, and inquiries as to the re-opening of the class have been received from many who are interested.

Miss Martha Fink, who made an intensive study of Parental Education last year as a fellow at Columbia university and the University of Minnesota under the Laura Spellman Rockefeller foundation, is assisting Miss Baker in planning the program of parental education at the college, and will co-operate in giving the courses. Other members of the faculty who will co-operate in presenting various phases of the behavior problems, are Dr. Mary Pope, Dr. Julia Kirkwood, Miss Harriet Howard, Miss Etta Mount and Miss Louise Farwell.
