Church School to Have All Classes Meet at Same Hour

The Winnetka Congregational church school is organized this year so that all the pupils may begin classes at 9:30 o'clock.

Meet in Evanston to Form North Shore Civic Organization

At a meeting held last Friday at the North Shore hotel in Evanston, William Edwards, Glencoe's building commissioner, was elected temporary chairman of a new civic organization for the north shore.

A suggested name for the new organization was the North Shore Relations committee. It will have for its membership five members from each of the Chambers of Commerce in Evanston, Wilmette, Winnetka, Glencoe and Highland Park. Other north shore towns will also be included in the membership as rapidly as possible.

The work of the organization will consist chiefly in the study of problems which affect the north shore as a whole. Such matters as grade separations through automobile traffic and the draining of the Skokie valley will receive the early attention of the new organization with the hope that united action of all the towns will result.

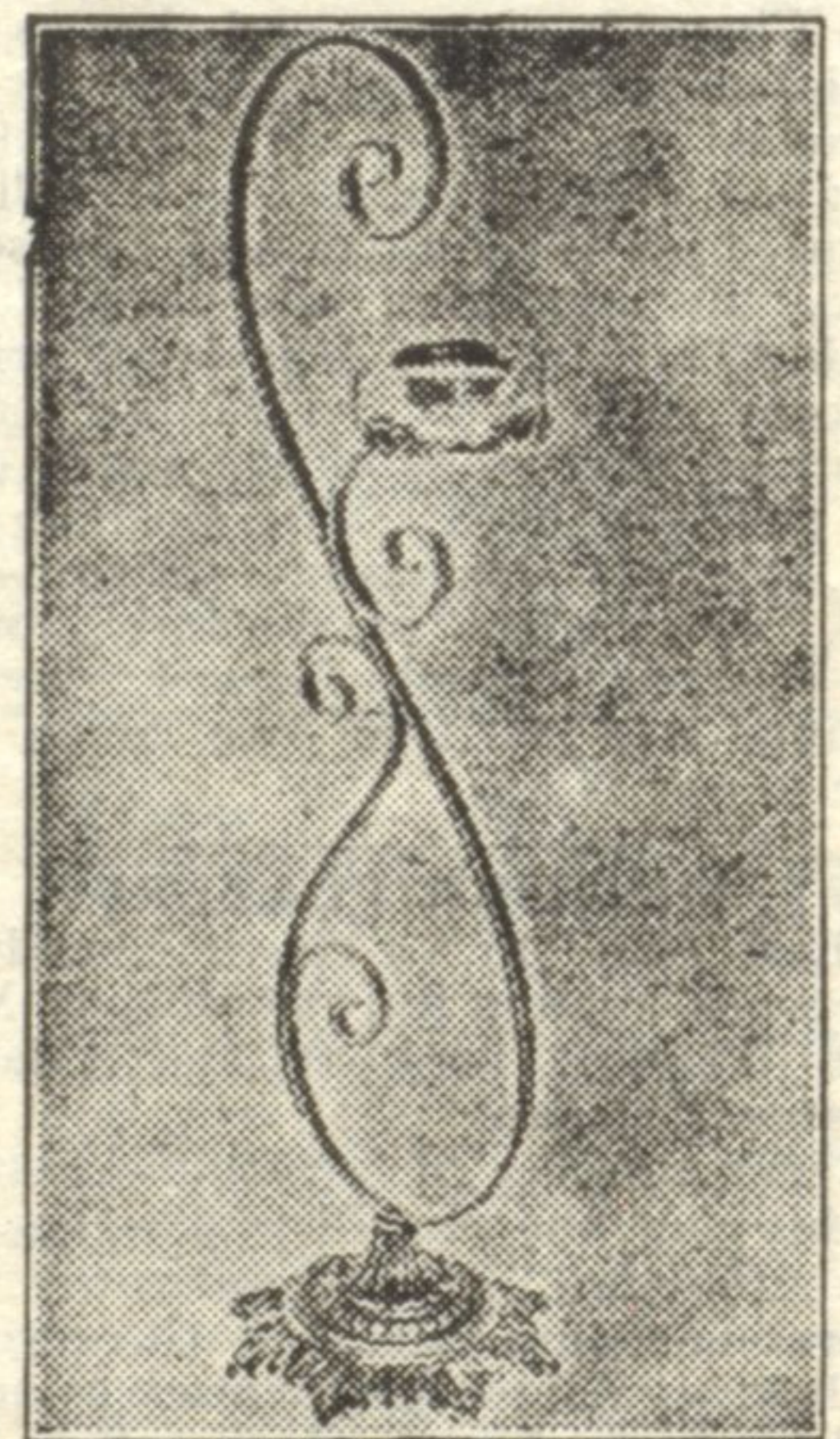
