Mission Leaders to Address Lutherans at Sunday Services

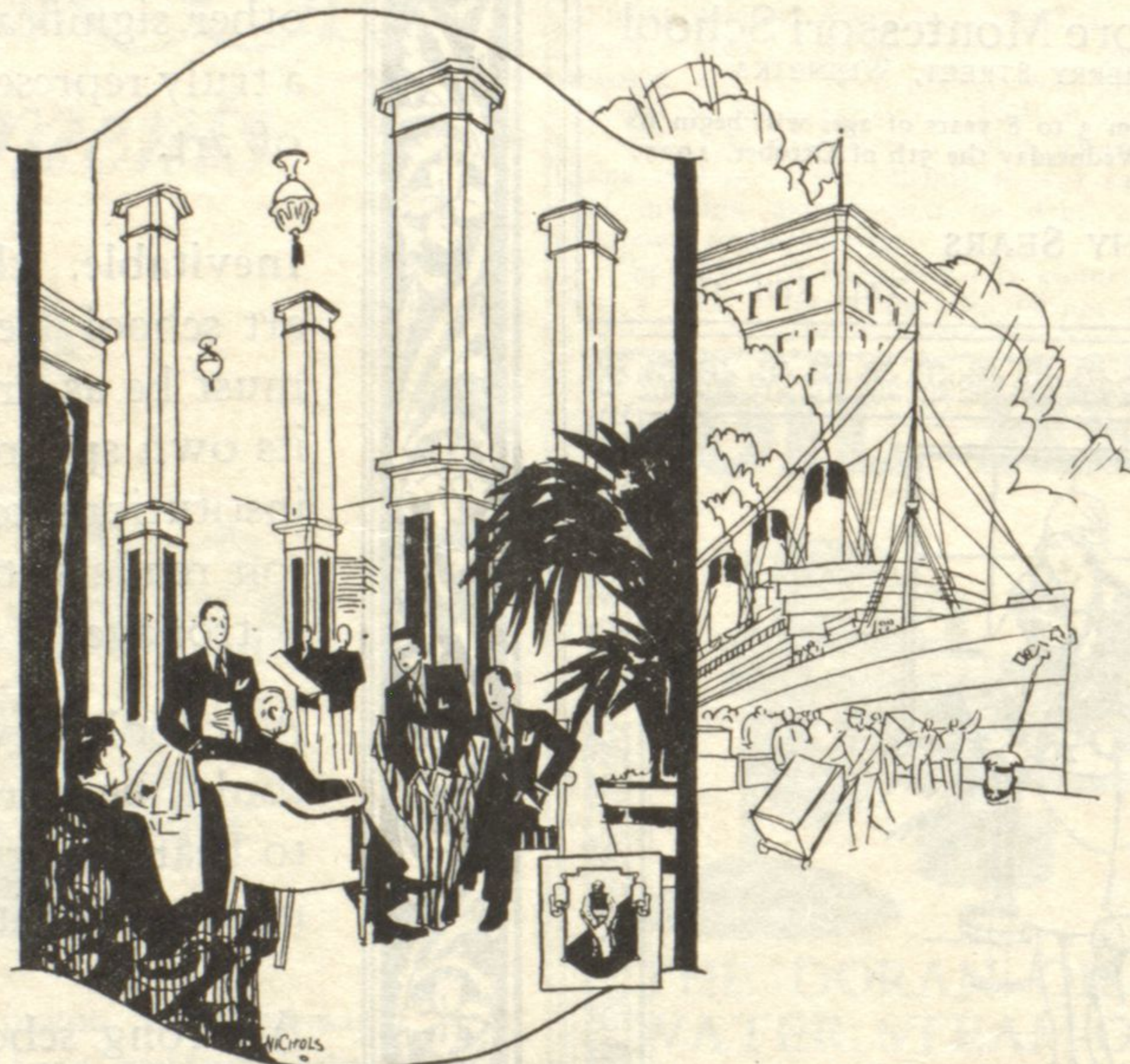
