1,800 Grade Crossings Eliminated Since 1916

According to information recently received by the Chicago Motor club, nearly 1,800 grade crossings have been eliminated since Federal Aid work was launched in 1916. This has been accomplished through two methodsby separating the grades and by changing the highway routes. Nearly two-thirds of these crossings were avoided by re-routing the roads. Of the 414 crossings eliminated during 1926 on Federal Aid projects, 202 of them were by relocation of highways. A number of states have taken steps to eliminate grade crossings. In making plans for pavement building many communities are including funds for the construction of under-passes and over-passes.






