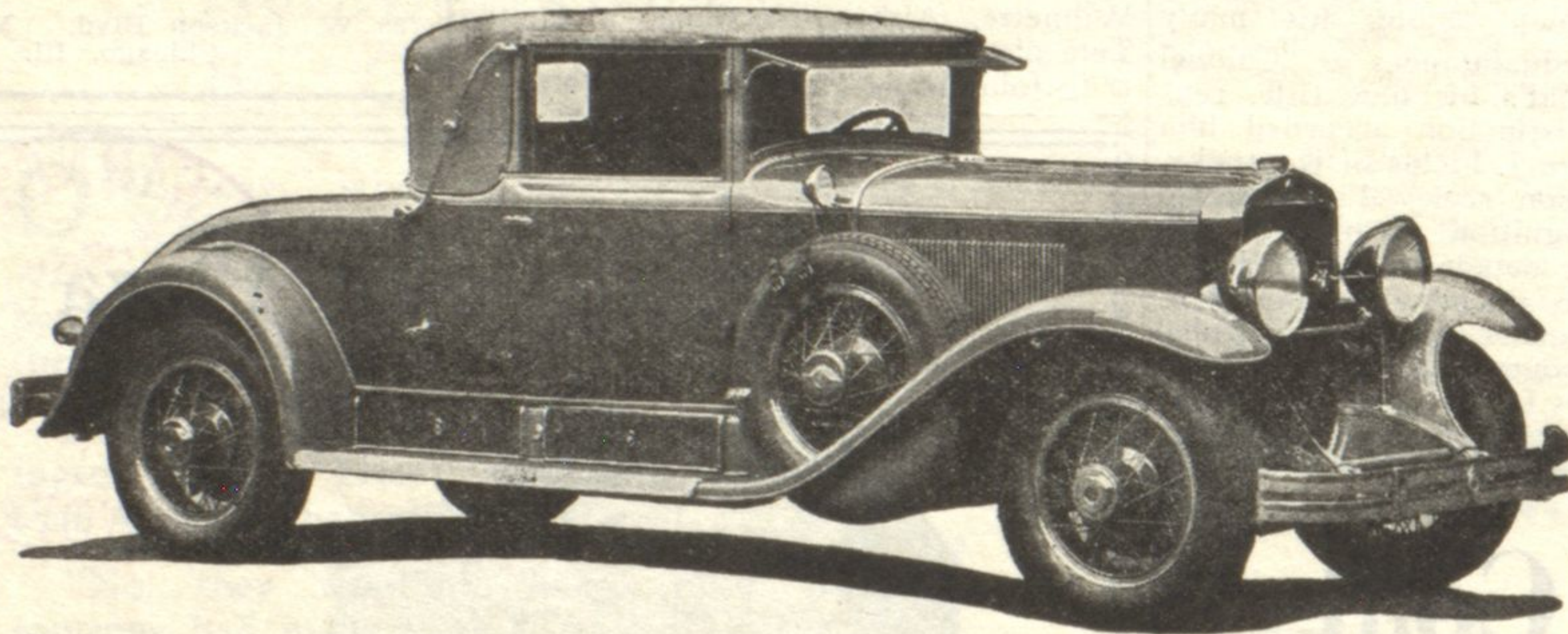

North Shore Men Attend Highways Parley in Chicago

Another meeting of the Advisory commission on Wider Highways was held at Hotel Sherman, Chicago, Tuesday afternoon, at which time various sub-committees met to organize into working groups.

The north division of this group comprises nine members, the personnel of which is Thomas J. Lynch, president of the Winnetka Chamber of Commerce; William Edwards, building commissioner of Glencoe; L. M. Willis, of Kenilworth; Charles S. Stewart, of Desplaines, and Si Mayer, A. D. Plamondon, Louis F. Swift, Andrew Halas, and John W. Dienhart, of Chicago.

Included in the 1928 construction program under the \$15,000,000 bond issue system of Cook county as suggested by the Chicago Regional Planning association, is the forty-foot pavement widening if Waukegan road from Milwaukee avenue to Lake street; Dempster road from Evanston limits to Milwaukee avenue; Milwaukee avenue from Chicago limits to Waukegan road and from River road to Dundee road;

Green Bay road from Dundee road to Lake county line.

Included in the new 40-foot pavement program are West Railroad avenue (Main street in Wilmette) from McCormick highway north, except completed section; Devon avenue from Milwaukee avenue to Cicero avenue.

In the new 20-foot pavement program are included Emerson Simpson and Crawford, Evanston; Dempster street from Milwaukee avenue to Rand road; Pfingston road from county line to Devon avenue; Central road from Rand road to Waukegan road; Grosse Point road from Harrison street to Touhy avenue; Main street from Lincoln avenue to McCormick boulevard; Busse avenue from Miner street to Touhy avenue and Wheeling road from county line to Rand road.
