

Forty Foot Streets in Elm Street Business Section Is Proposed

An informal public hearing on the widening of streets in the Elm street business section was held at the village hall Tuesday evening, at which no formal action was taken but as the result of which Village Engineer Frank A. Windes was instructed to compile various data and information to be presented at the next meeting of the

council at which time the date of a second public hearing will be determined. This information will include estimates on the various types of widening.

The sections involved in the contemplated improvement, are Spruce street from Center to Birch; Elm street from Chestnut to Birch; Oak street from Linden to Chestnut and Chestnut street from Spruce to Oak.

The pavement here at present is 27 feet. It is proposed to widen it to 40 feet in the clear, the same as it now is from Tower road to Scott avenue in Hubbard Woods.

"Look Both Ways," Surest Safety Rule in Crossing Street

The poster issued by the Chicago Motor club to the school children of northern Illinois and northern Indiana for the month of September admonishes children to look both ways before crossing the streets. The safety lesson accompanying the poster says:

"It is seldom that either a child or adult person is injured who crosses the street safely and correctly.

"The safety poster that goes with this lesson shows the mother telling her little girl to look both ways before crossing the street.

"Faithful observance of this simple precaution will save many a child from being hurt. As you cross the street, look both ways—first, look to the left—then look to the right. Now, there's a proper and safe place to cross the street. Each child should remember to cross the street at the corner or intersection.

"If there are stop and go lights at the crossing, then stand at the curb while the light is red—and walk across quickly when the green is on. More men, women and children are killed in

the middle of the block than anywhere else on the streets. Therefore, all children must be warned each day to avoid crossing streets in middle of blocks.

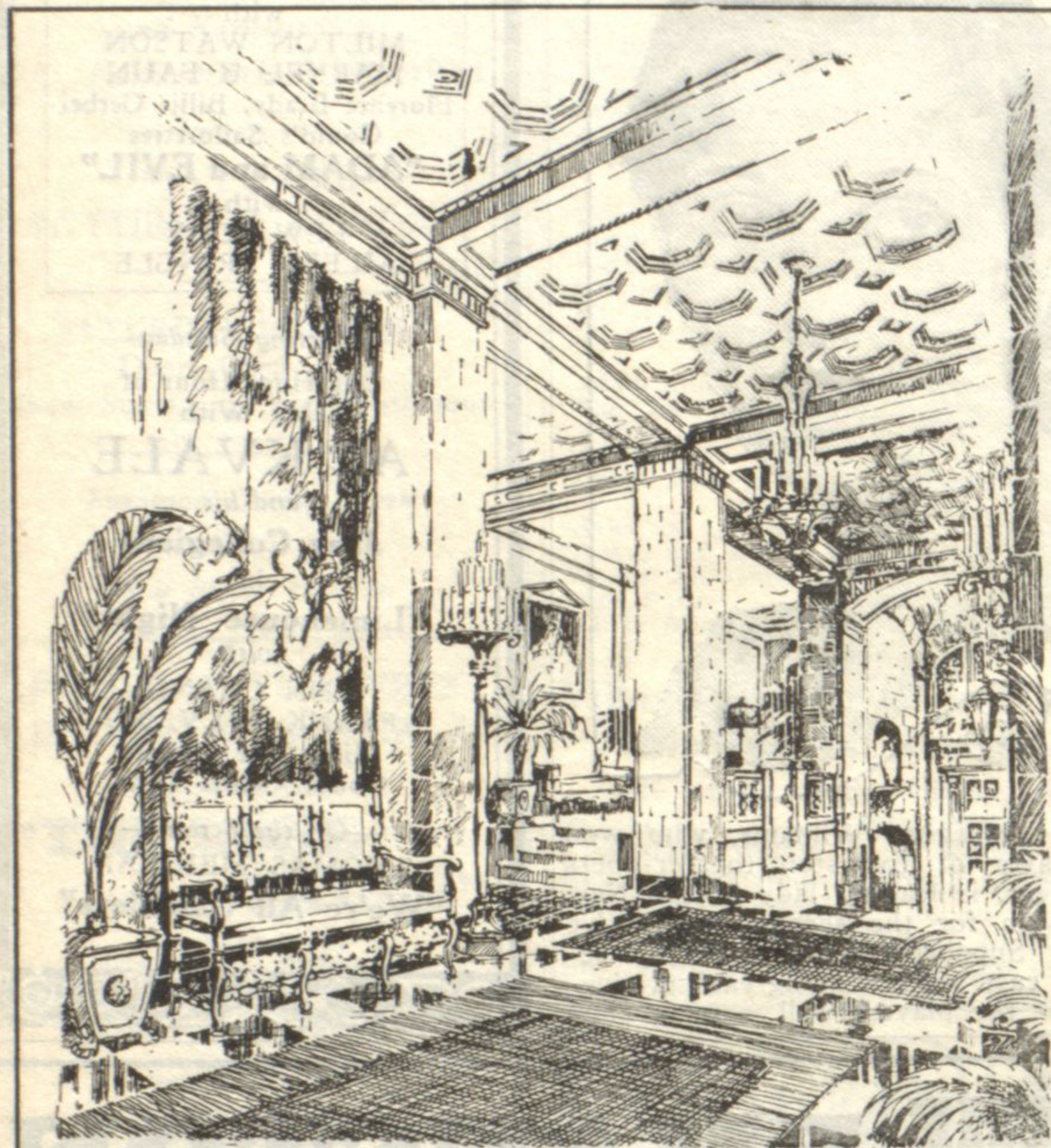
"It is dangerous, likewise, to run across the street. Use your eyes—look both ways—then walk across at the intersection. Each boy and girl might be asked to make a promise to obey these easily remembered safety rules.

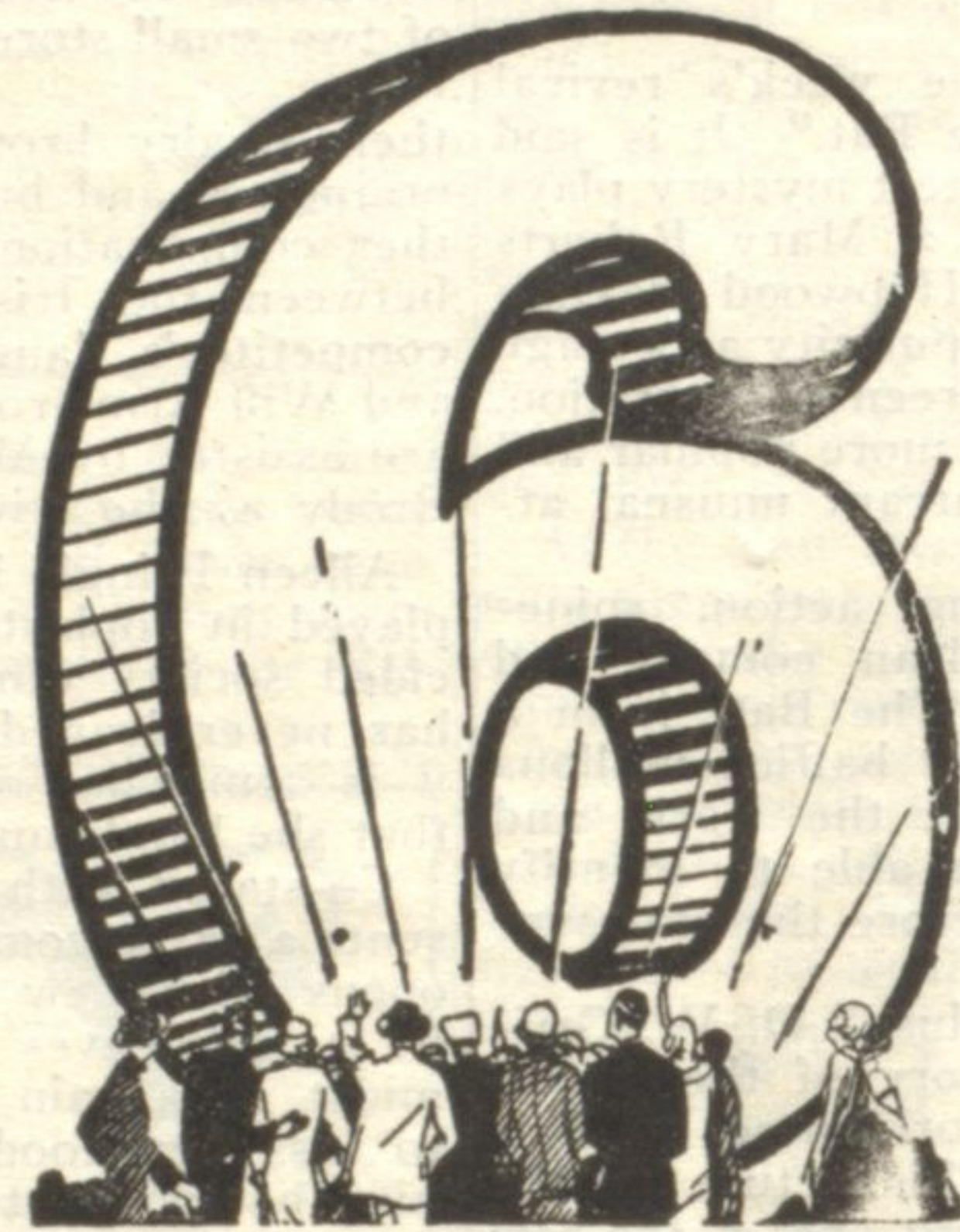
