There is much poverty, crudity, atheism and vagabondism, many things to make a black picture, but there was a spirit of enthusiasm in the effort of the millions of people, trying to make a new civilization run by the workers.

The things which are normal in the capitalistic form of government are exactly opposite in the communistic form. The former idea is to work for a profit to one's self, and in the soviet form the idea is to work for the welfare of the state. One loses his vote, if he seeks to make a profit only to himself. The soviet form of government adheres to the right of the workers to rule the country, exactly the opposite of things as they were before the revolution.

Whether in matters industrial, spiritual, or political, the old order of things has been entirely cast aside, and a new civilization is being attempted, the success or failure of which remains to be seen.
