

Yell Leaders, Mascot and Crowd Give Grid Season Flying Start

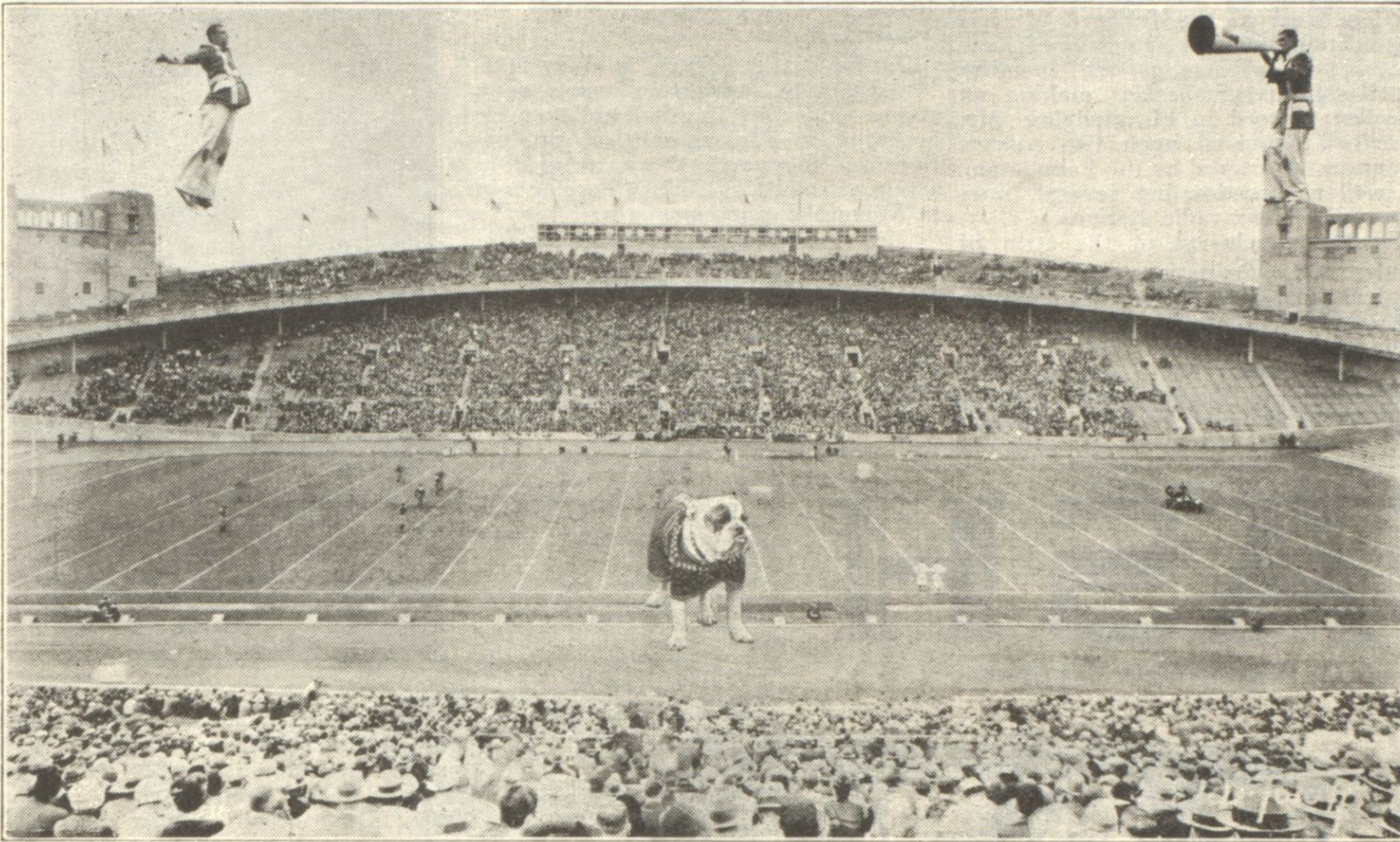
