A magnificent range of torm and color will be found in the Darwin tulip, most suitable for a formal garden. They should be planted in groups of a dozen or more of one variety. The Clara Butt, a delicate apple-blossom pink, with just a touch of salmon and silver shading, is one of the best of the Darwin variety. Farncombe Sanders, a very large rosy-scarlet with white base, is a popular variety.

The Darwins bloom in May, and for soft colors in all tones of pink and red, mauve to royal purple and violets to a color bordering on black, they are unequalled.


