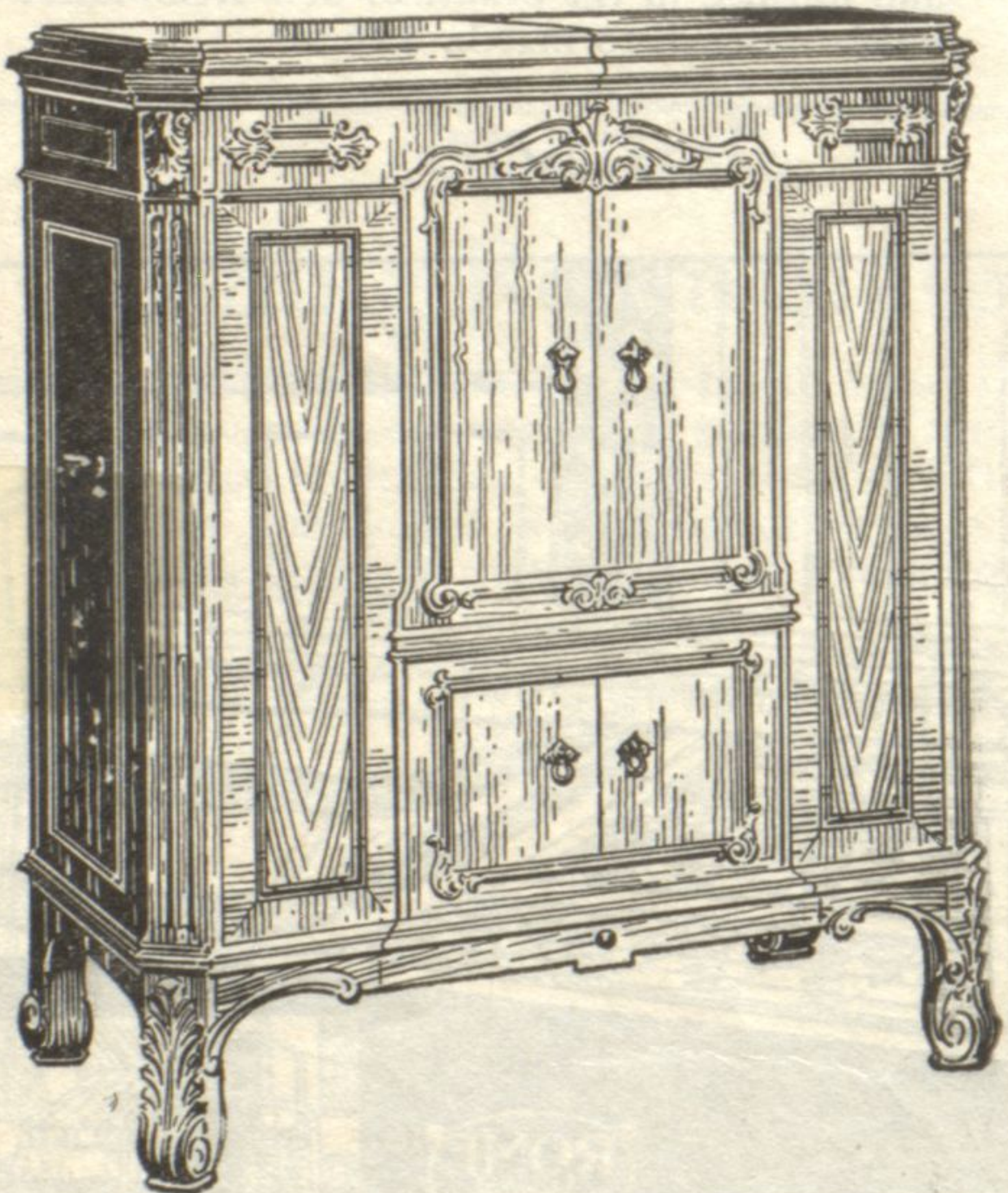

A Court of Honor for the entire North Shore area, similar to the one held at the New Trier High school last May, is being planned for the middle of November.

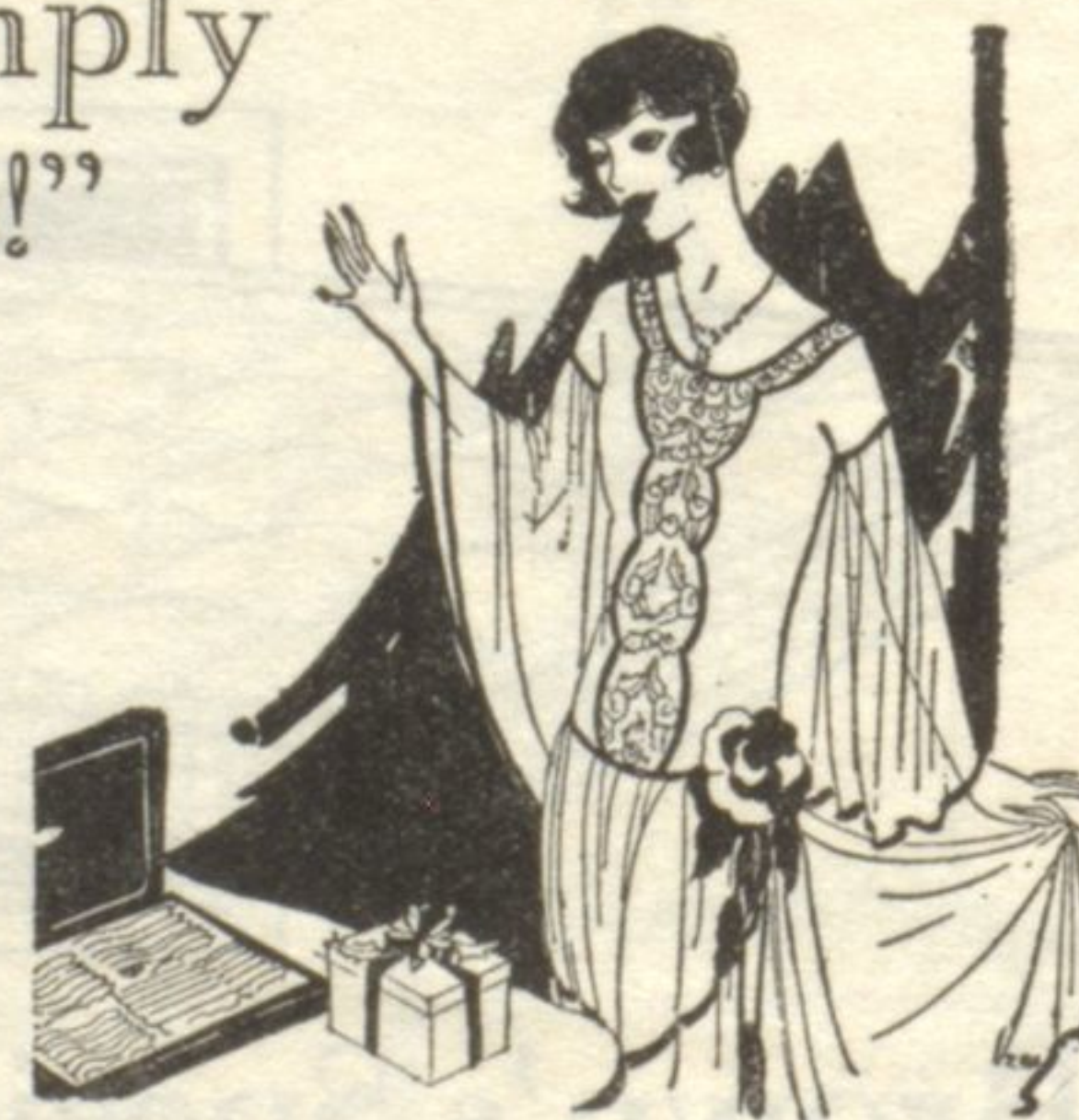
