Illini Look Forward to Tussle With Wolverines

Illinois football fans look ahead to the homecoming game, October 29, when Michigan plays in the stadium. Practically 50,000 tickets have been sold but the stadium seats 67,000.

Michigan last played a homecoming game in the stadium in 1925 winning from an eleven captained by Red Grange 3 to 0 on a slippery field. But the victory afforded little balm to the Michigan cohorts who had seen the Galloping Ghost dedicate the stadium at the 1924 homecoming Michigan game with one of greatest individual performances in the history of football. After taking the kickoff back 95 yards for a touchdown, the Red Head finished off his afternoon's work with four more touchdowns against a stunned bunch of fighting Wolverines. Last year at Ann Arbor Michigan won from the Illini 13 to 0.
