Kenilworth Board Votes to Issue Water Certificates

An ordinance providing for the issuance of water certificates to the amount necessary to cover the cost of constructing a new water pumping and filtration plant for the Village of Kenilworth was passed by the Kenilworth Board of Trustees at its regular monthly meeting last Monday night. The adopted program of financing the proposition had previously been declared legal by Major Edgar B. Tolman, Chicago attorney and legal expert upon municipal bonding matters. It is considered probable that the board will vote to advertise for bids on the new system at its December meeting and that the contract will be approved at the following session.

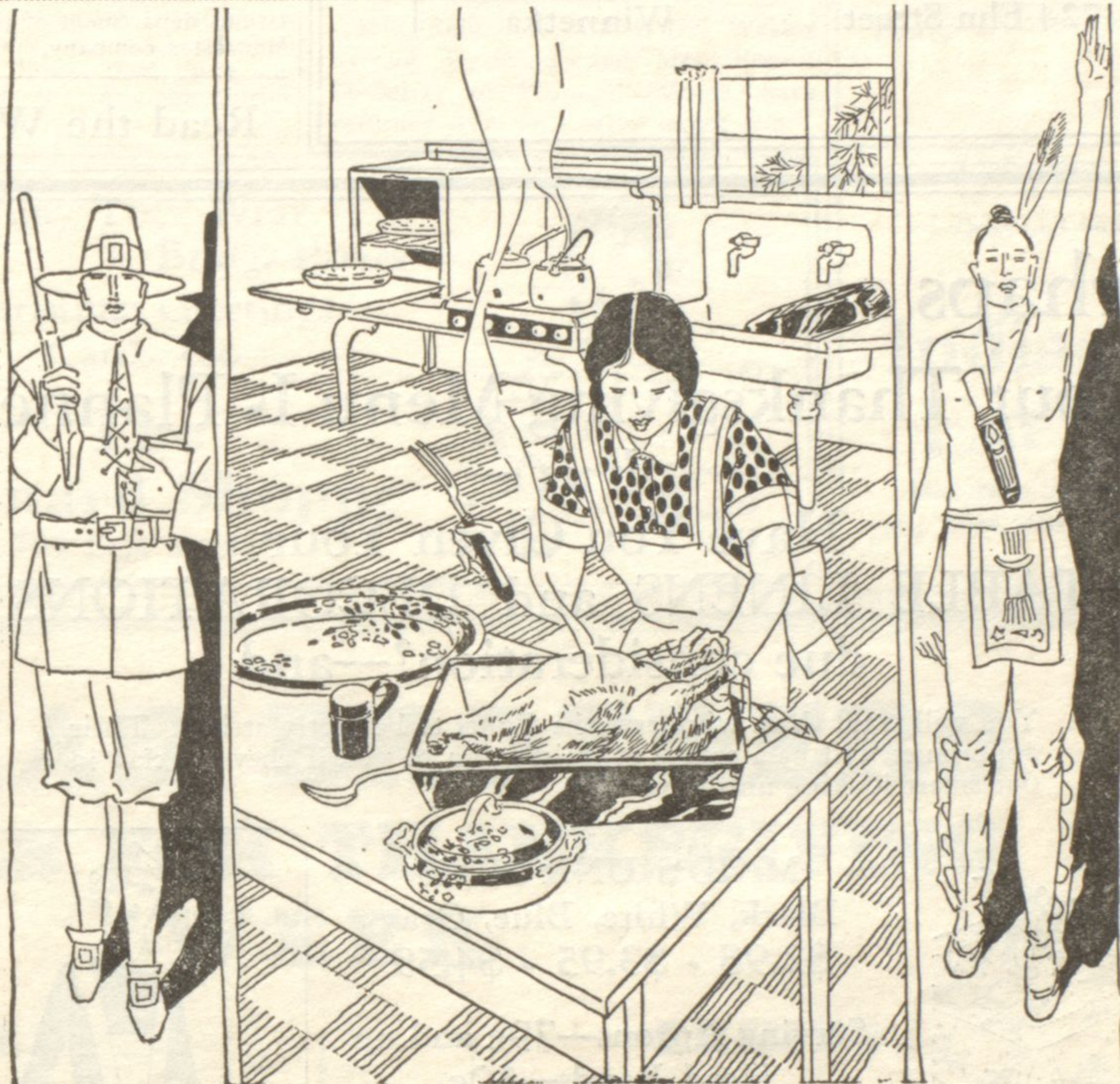
