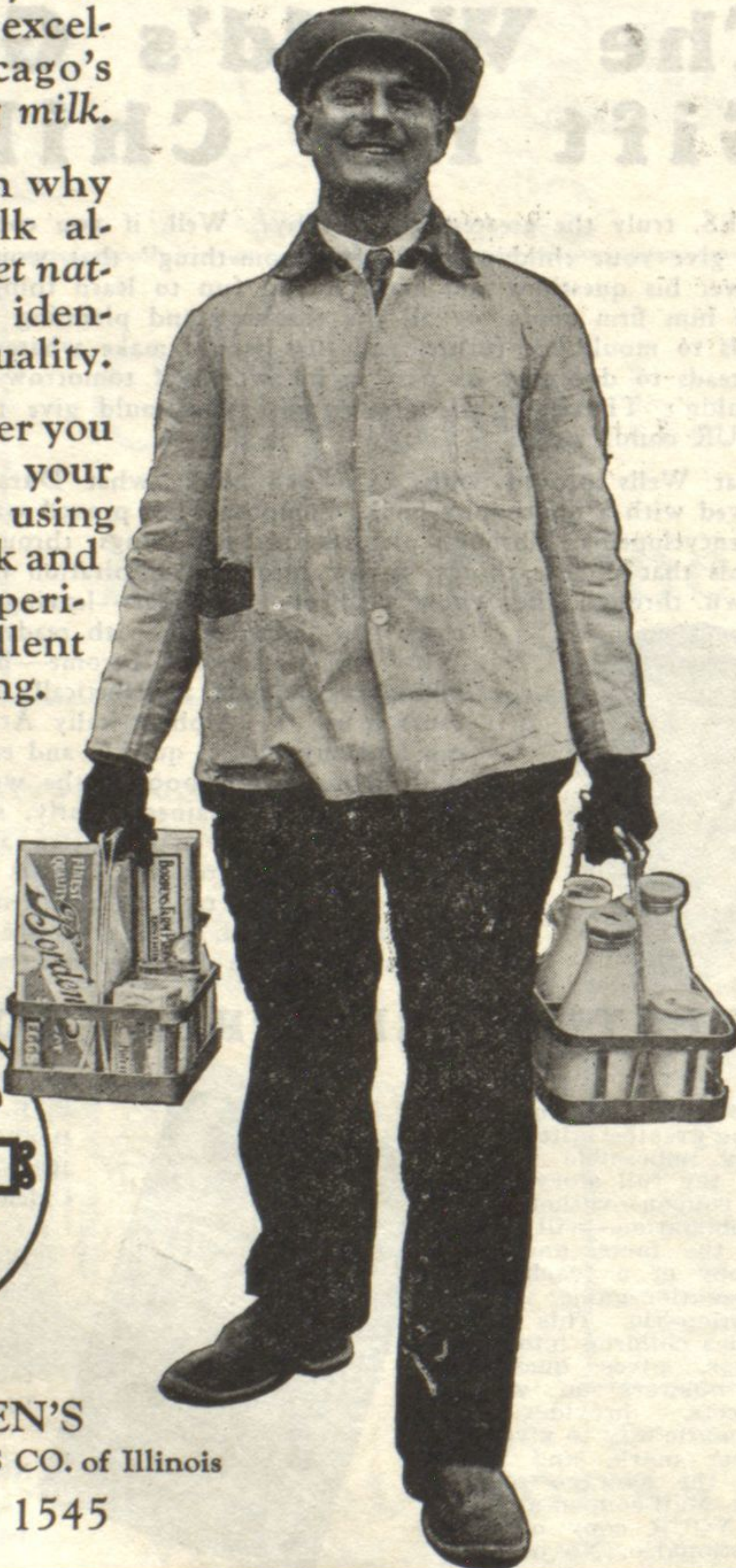

The adult company also performs Saturday and Sunday evenings, and the children's players Saturday and Sunday afternoons at 3. Marie Agnes Foley is directing the company.

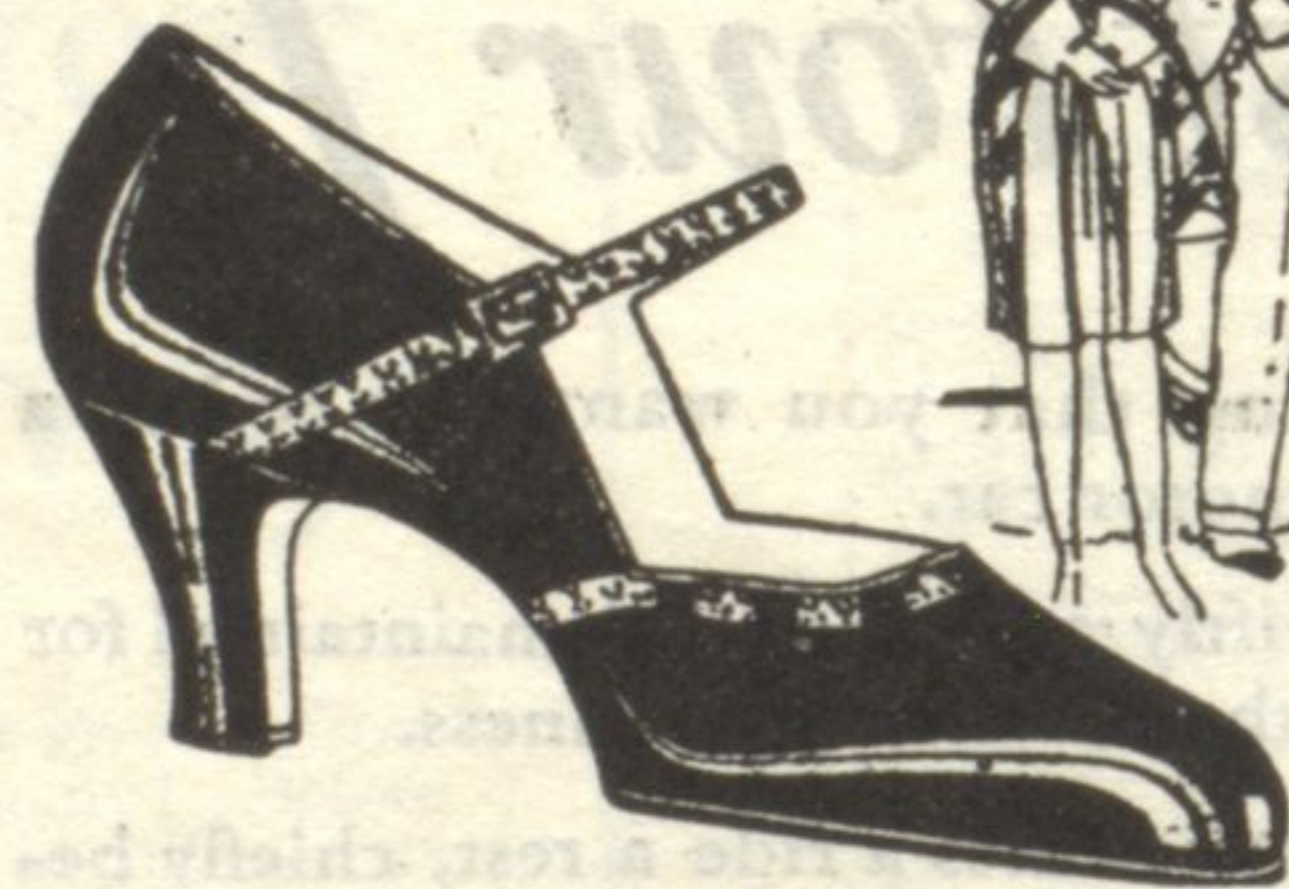
Local Women Elected to Arden Shore Offices
