Christian Science Churches

"Ancient and Modern Necromancy, Alias Mesmerism and Hypnotism, Denounced" was the subject of the Lesson-sermon in all Churches of Christ, Scientist, Sunday, November 27.

The Golden Text was from Isaiah 19:22, "The Lord shall smite Egypt: he shall smite and heal it.

Among the citations which comprised the lesson-sermon was the following from the Bible: "And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God. And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for the glory of God did lighten it, and the Lamb is the light thereof" (Rev. 21: 3, 23).

The lesson-sermon also included the following passages from the Christian Science textbook, "Science and Health with Key to the Scriptures," by Mary Baker Eddy: "This city of our God has no need of sun or satellite, for love is the light of it, and divine Mind is its own interpreter. All who are saved must walk in this light. Mighty potentates and dynasties will lay down their honors within the heavenly city. Its gates open towards light and glory both within and without, for all is good, and nothing can enter that city, which 'defileth, . . . or maketh a lie'" (p. 577).
