Figures Show Big Building Year for Wilmette

WILMETTE, with an exceedingly bright outlook from a building point of view during the new year, is also able to take a most pleasant retrospective vision of her achievements in this line during the year just closed.

From figures for the year 1927, just completed by Superintendent of Public Works C. C. Shultz, 342 building permits were issued during that period, authorizing a total expenditure in both new and remodeling work of \$2,120,759, an increase of 37 in the number of permits issued, with a corresponding increase of \$532,890 in building improvements thus authorized.

A further gratifying feature of the report, as will be noted in the appended detailed statistics for both the years 1926 and 1927, is the marked increase in the number of residences. In 1926 a total of 111 permits for this type of building was issued, with a value of \$1,380,300, while for the year just ended, the total was 128 and the valuation was \$1,784,550.

Under the classification of "apartments, commercial and public," there was a total of 14 permits the past year, as against only six, in 1926, and the value of the new work in the business area the past year is \$189,075, as against only \$72,600 in 1926.


