Predict Real Fight on Zoning Provision

duction be made in the number of families per acre.

Opposes Drastic Change

Mr. Schell is unalterably opposed to any material change in the present zoning ordinance, he told the council, unless it be a slight change, perhaps, in the number of families permissible per acre in territory zoned "C" commercial.

He made it plain that he is as firmly opposed to the extension of "C" commercial area in the village, but would safeguard with every precaution the development of this class of territory, already thus zoned.

Both in the first public hearing on this subject, and later Winnetka property owners expressed themselves as listed among those opposing "exten-

sion of the 'C' commercial zoned area," Mr. Schell asserted in an interview this week.

Some of these people, he said, when it was explained that no effort is made to extend the "C" commercial area into new territory, whatever, but merely a desire to protect Winnetka as it now is, quickly changed front and admitted they had been laboring under a wrong impression.

Winnetka-Owned Property

He also called attention to the fact that 90 percent of the business property in Winnetka is owned by men who not only reside in the village but also own the building in which their business is conducted.

With this vital interest at stake, Mr. Schell pointed out, it is with the highest motives that the business men of Winnetka participate in the community's development. They are just as much interested and perhaps more so, he felt, in maintaining the present lofty ideals of the village, than many of those who simply reside here and have their business interests elsewhere.

It is this, and this spirit alone which makes Winnetka the Winnetka it is today, he declared, and that condition has resulted in the development under the present restrictions, which the proponents of further restrictions would now change and which the business men, with both their homes and business at stake, would retain, just about as it is. It has proven the wisdom of its provision, Mr. Schell feels.

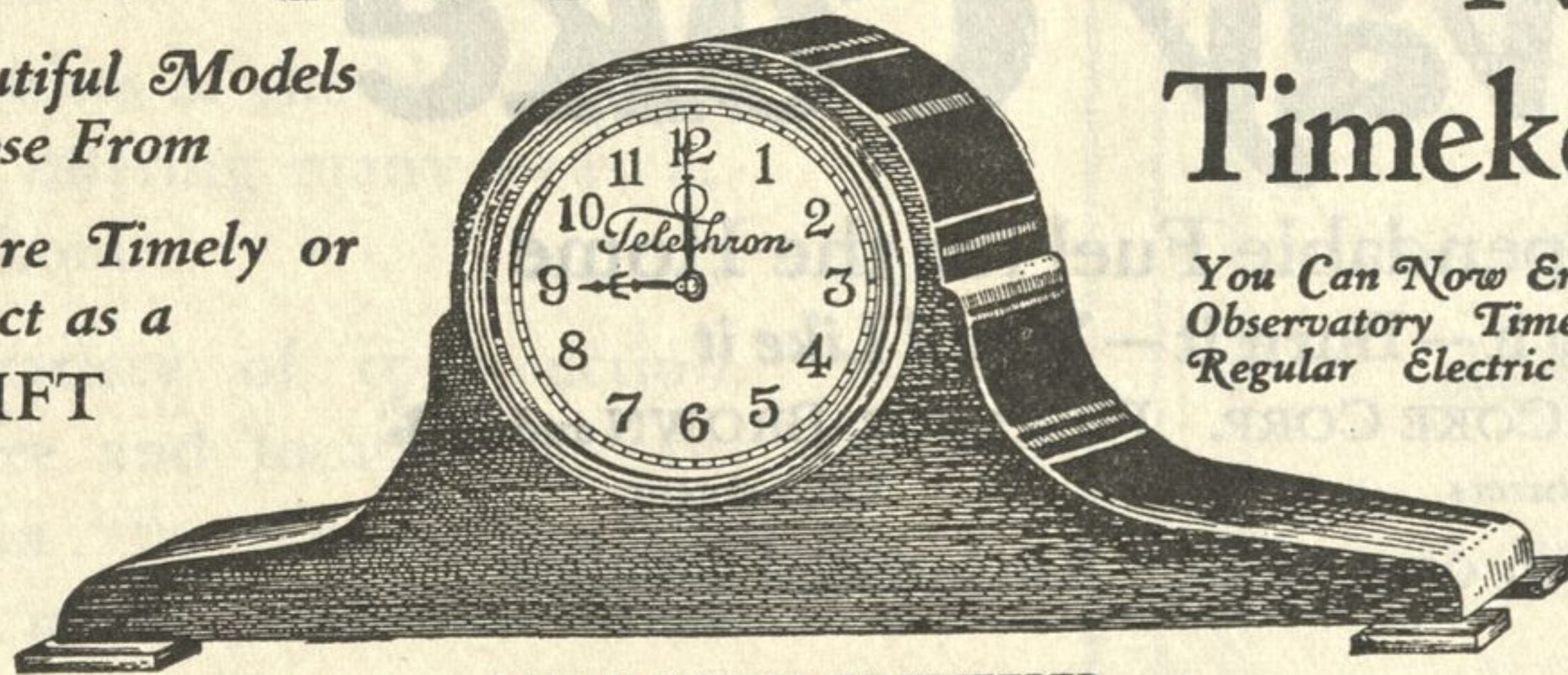
