to Discuss Great
Religious Leaders**

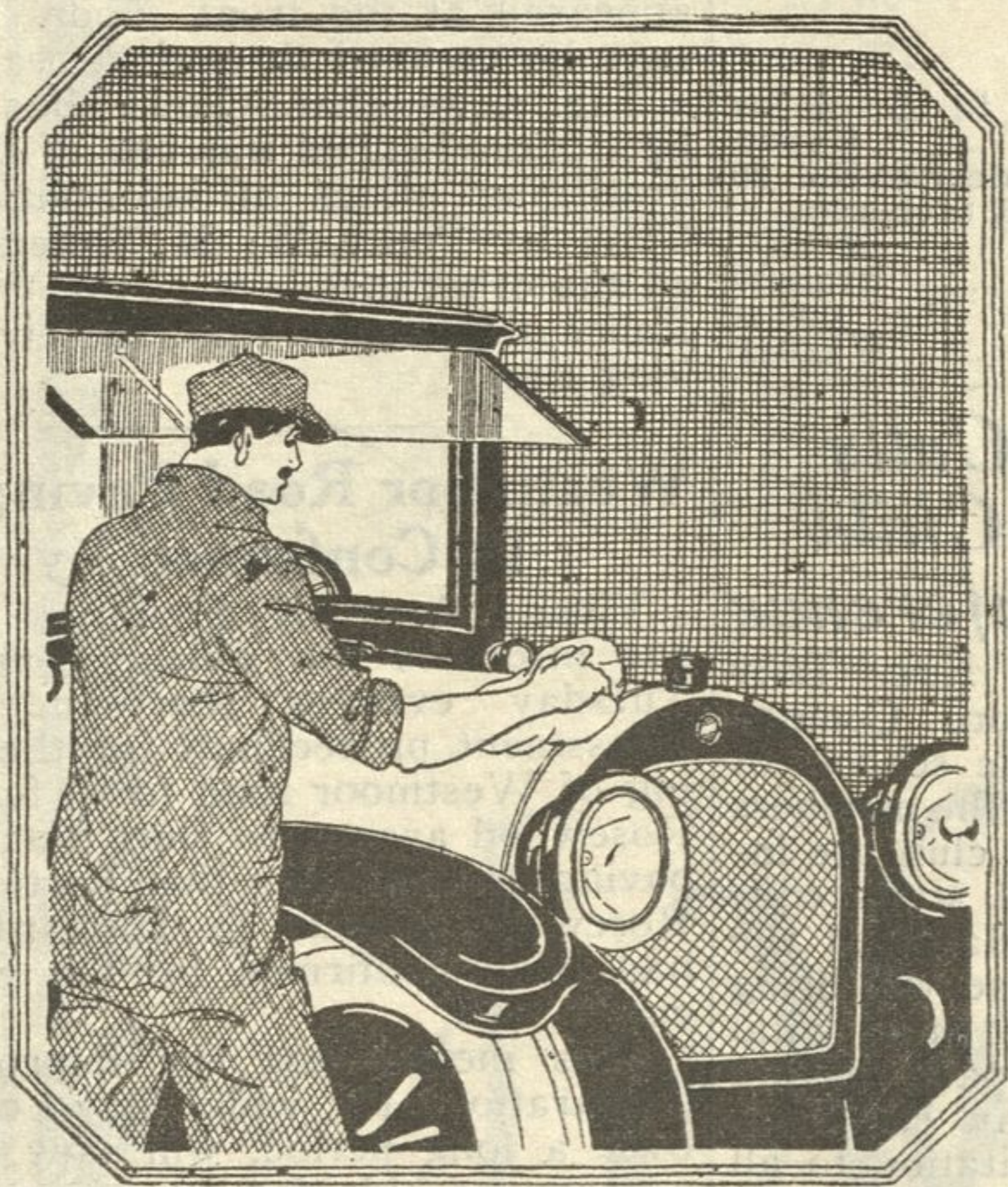
At the Vesper service of the Congregational church Sunday, February 26, the Rev. Thomas A. Goodwin will talk about Lyman Abbott and his significant contribution to religion in the restatement of the Christian faith in terms of our own time.

Subsequently, Mr. Goodwin will discuss Walter Rauschenbusch and his pioneer work in the application of the Gospel to social questions; D. L. Moody and his remarkable success in winning the individual to loyalty to Jesus by means of personal influence; General William Booth and his world famous work among those whom society regarded as hopeless, and Watts O. Pye and his statesman-like service in the interior of China.

"Probably nothing is as helpful and inspiring when we attempt a difficult task as the example of one who has accomplished that task with distinction," says Mr. Goodwin. "This is especially true in the attempt to live the Christian life. Accordingly, I have chosen the lives of five quite different men who have in our modern world lived lives which have indeed been truly Christian."
