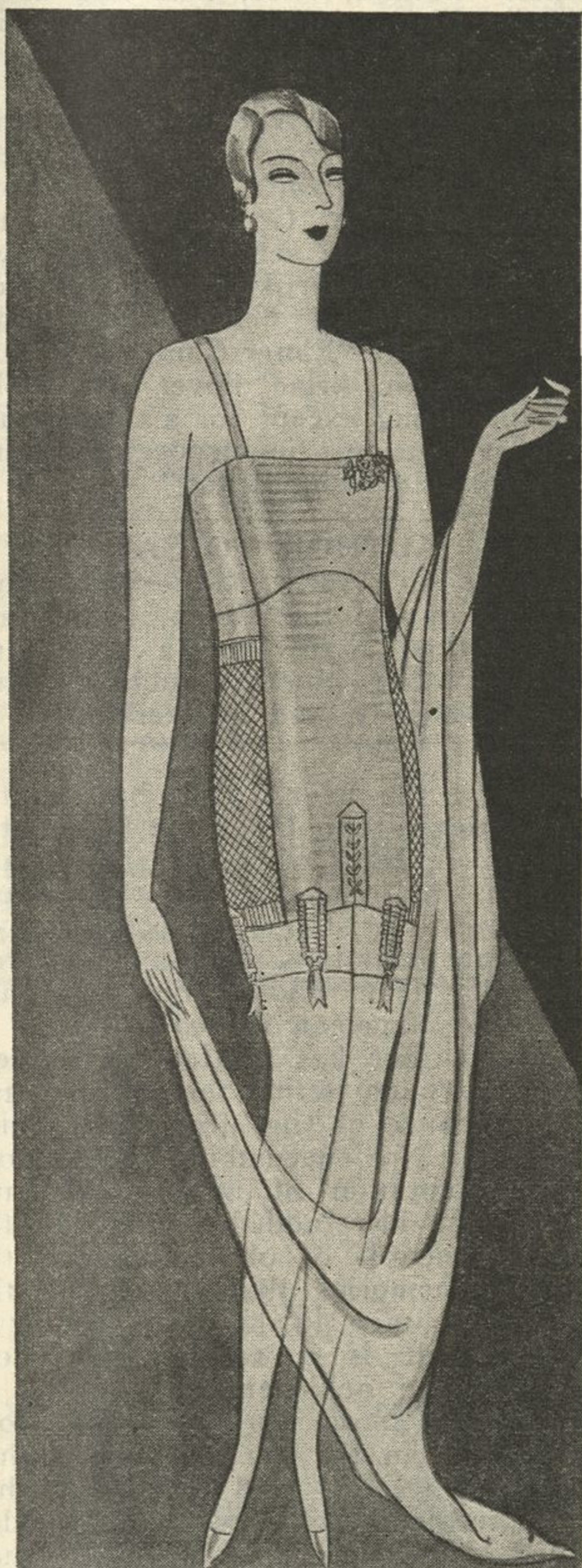
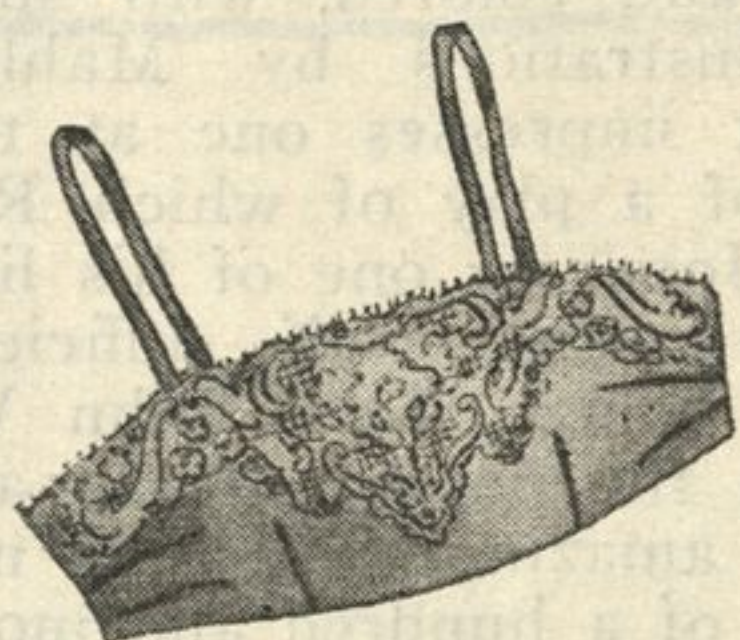


LINGERIE ENDEARED TO THE MODE FOR THE MORE "FEMININE"

The pajama ensemble at the right is designed of red crepe de chine in combination with a highly lustrous gold material, \$16.95.

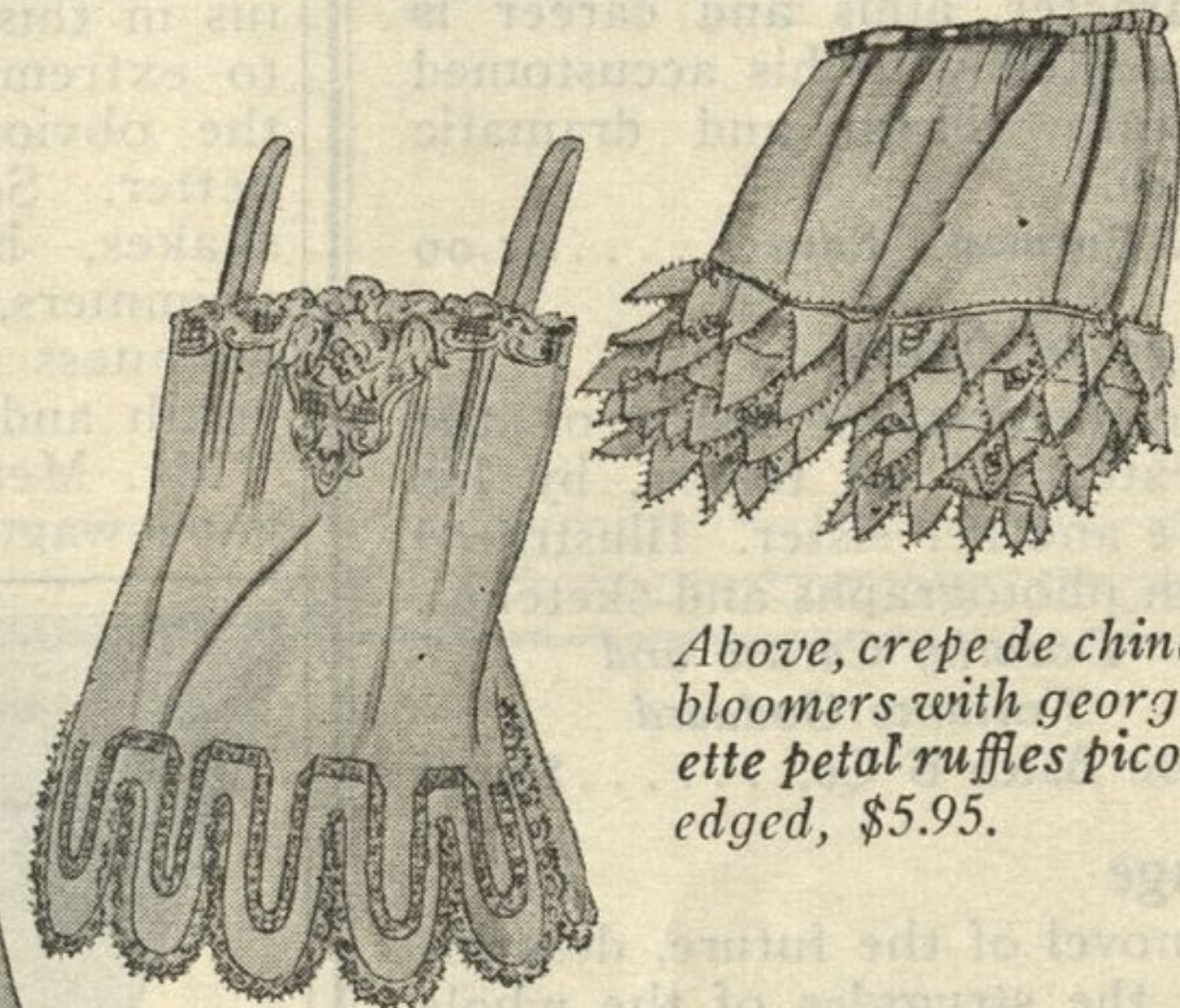
Soft marabou trims this crepe satin negligee while intricate shirring smartens its cuffs, \$22.50.
