Miss Winifred Berglund of 120 Green Bay road, Glencoe, entertained a group of friends last Friday evening.

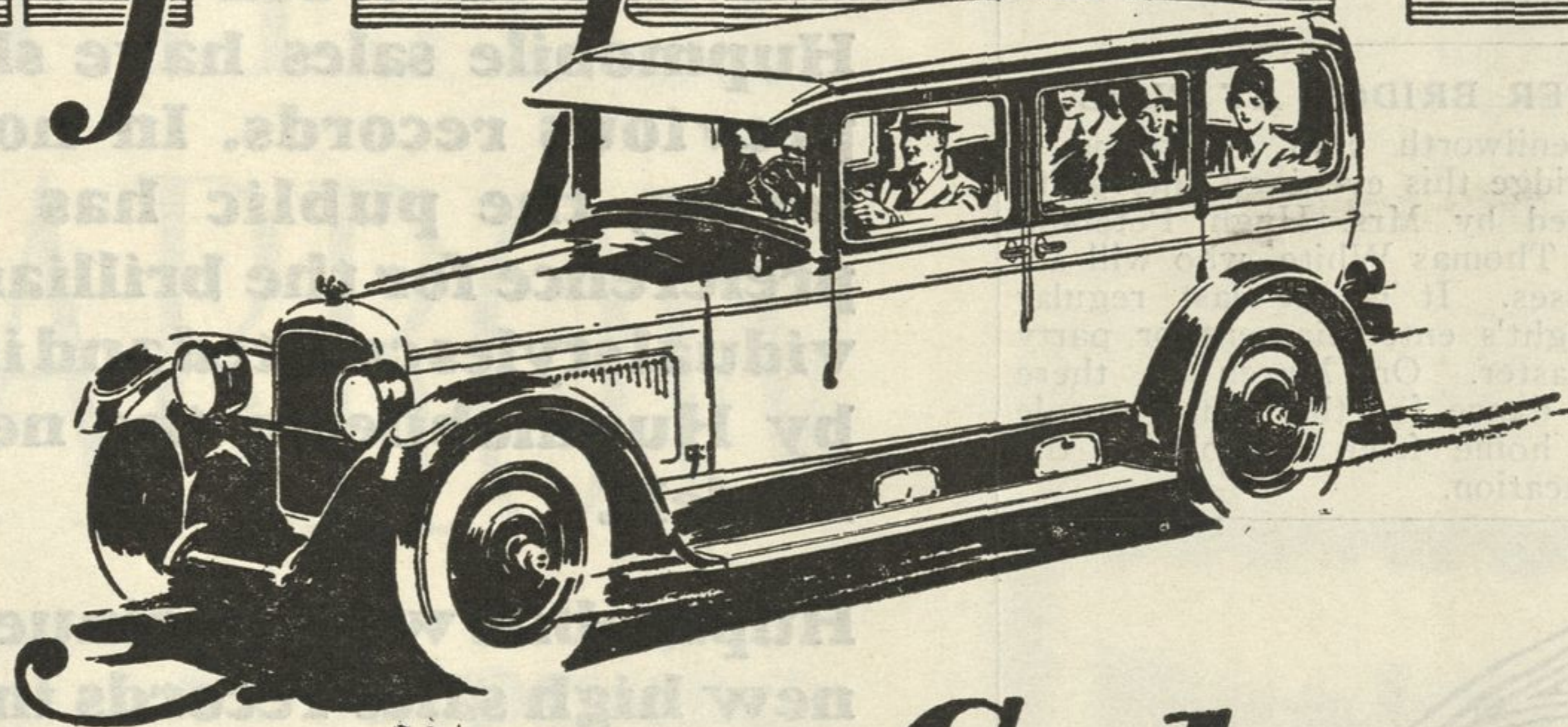
