### Edward Paul Wetzel, Long Sought, Is in Custody, Police Learn

Chief of Police W. M. Peterson received a telegram Thursday informing him that Edward Paul Wetzel, who formerly operated a taxi in Winnetka had been arrested at Lansing, Mich., where he is being held for violation of the Dyer act, transporting a stolen car from one state to another.

Chief Peterson had before him a volume of correspondence and telegrams from officers in various parts of the United States and Canada relative to Wetzel, whom he has been endeavoring to locate since the spring of 1924, when Wetzel, it is charged, went south with a mortgaged car he had purchased from the Skokie Motor Co., and leaving behind, also, 19 bogus checks for \$969.50.
