Their numbers will include a new composition for two pianos and orchestra written by Prof. Oldberg during his sojourn last summer in Estes Park. It will have its initial Evanston performance.

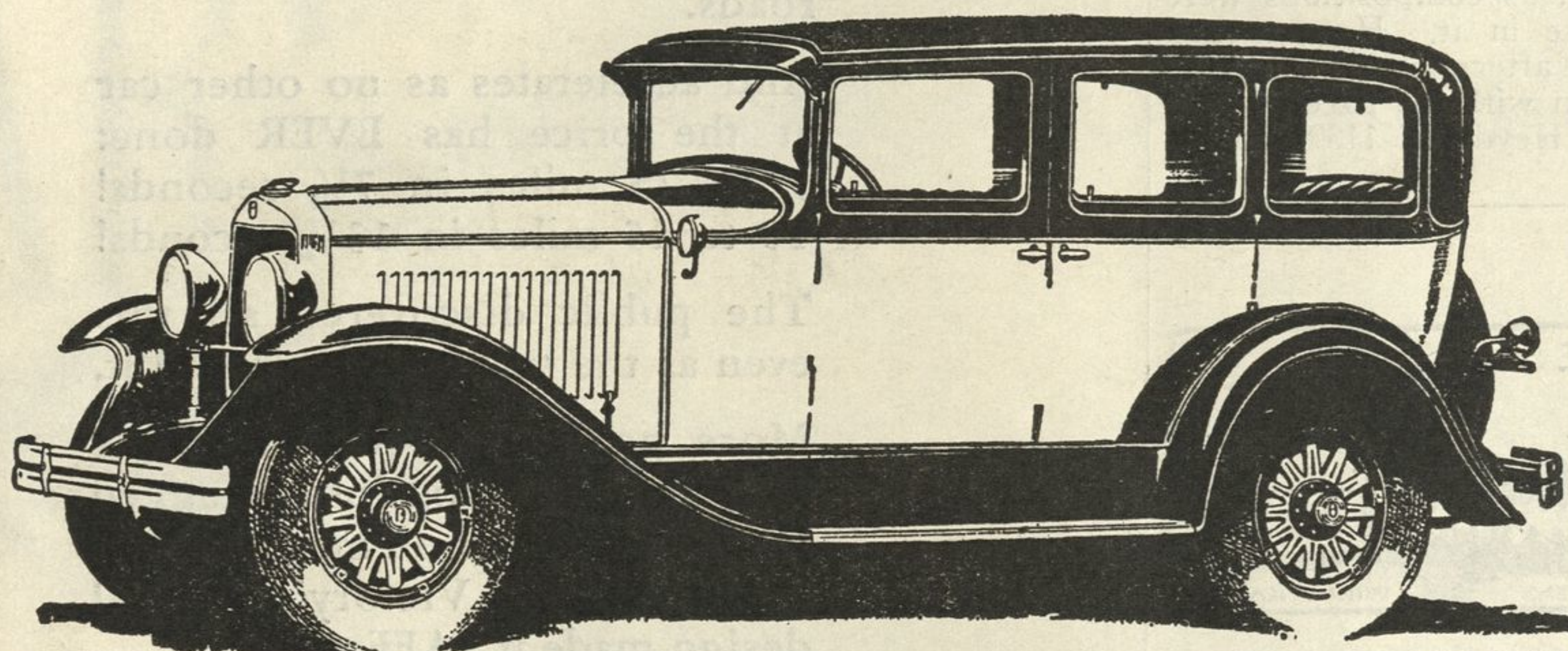
